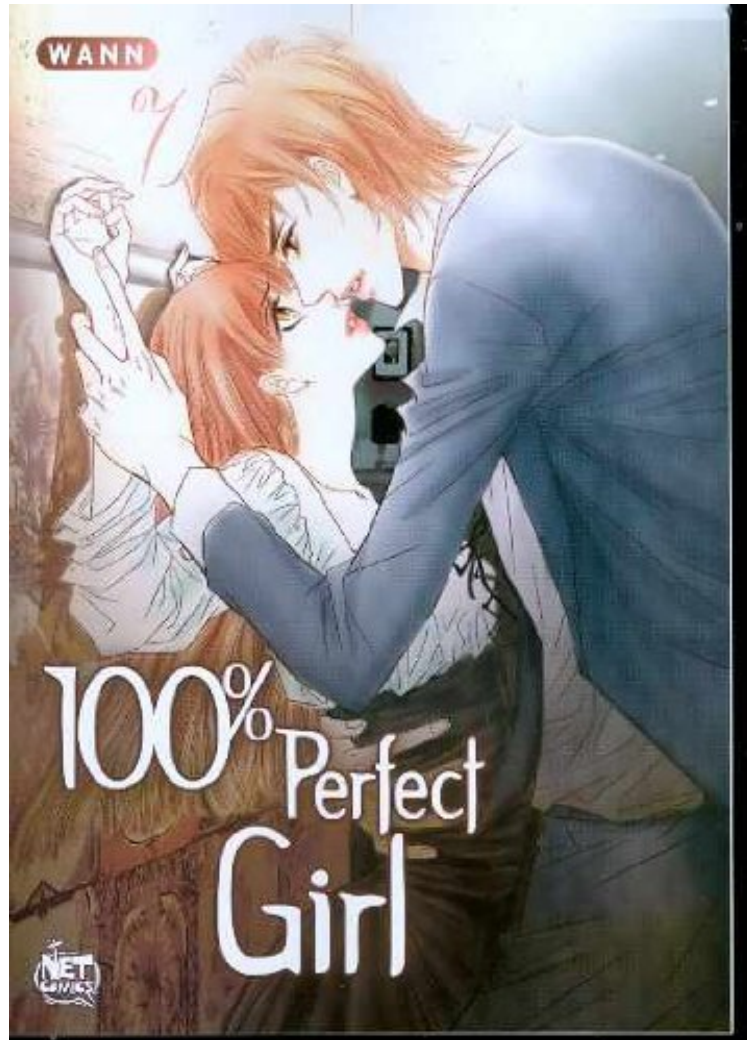

I immediately purchased my copy because I've been a dedicated fan of the 100% Perfect Girl series thus far. It has beautiful artwork and a soap opera worthy storyline.However, volume 7, for me, was a bit of a let down. I'm surprised I didn't love it more because it is probably the darkest volume so far and normally that's the best part of all stories, when there is tragedy and danger. However, I feel this volume has squashed almost all of the romance out of the series.Jay finally confesses to Jarte that she loves him, but only seconds

after making a dark deal with his half-brother Ewan that she'll sleep with him if he lets Jarte free. I'll try not to reveal too much but lets just say what ensues after is a misunderstood situation, a very depressed Jay and a dark outcome. Something also happens to Luigi (which upset me because at this point he is the one man who "loves" Jay who isn't trying to hurt her and actually respects her wishes). Jarte has become so possessive that he is looking insane (more so if you thought this already) and Ewan now loves Jay in his own twisted mind (at least he regrets what he did to her).
