I put the book down and had to emotionally let myself calm down a little bit with the ending, but honestly, I think Yuu Watase did the very best she could with the circumstances. It sort of reminded me of the movie "Her" by the end.The rest of the book is a collection of her short

stories. At first, I thought, "I wanted more Absolute Boyfriend!!" But once I gave the other stories a chance, I really loved them. I have been a fan of Yuu Watase for years now (Fushigi Yugi, Alice 19th, Imadoki, etc.) For a while, I had made it my mission to read every series Watase put out. As an English-speaking audience, we do not normally have access to the short stories, unless we subscribe to Shoujo Beat, and even then, we may not get everything that an author releases in Japan. So, how else were we going to get these short stories? Once I began to think of it in that perspective, I became very happy with volume 6.
