I was able to get it recently for a great price, used, on here. At \$39.99, this is a great book. The book is solid, great paper, sewn binding, book mark, and cover. There are some extras, but nothing that will blow you away. Besides the 6-issue series, the first issue of the regular series is included too, which is drawn by Darwyn Cooke. The oversized edition, makes his and Van Sciver's art work look amazing. As for the story, this is one of my favorite Green Lantern stories. As soon as I learned that The Green Lantern was more SciFi and not just another "mutant" or person with magical powers, I was hooked. I have been a scifi lover pretty much since I could walk so The Green Lantern series was right up my alley. So I began to research where to start actually READING Green Lantern and my first purchase was the newer hardcover release of the Green Lantern Omnibus, which collects from his first appearance or creation through the first comics of his own ongoing series. Now these stories are decent reading but they were written waaaay back when comics were extremely campy and about good constantly prevailing over evil. So I made it about half way through this enormous Omnibus and got a little bored with it. Then I did some more research on the modern Green Lantern stories and learned about Geoff Johns. I immediately knew this is where I wanted to go next, so I purchased Secret Origins hardcover. Now most of this comic was a kind of recap as to what I previously read in the Omnibus but there were a lot of new elements and additions to the story which made it a little more modern and likeable not to mention the art is GREAT. Immediately after Secret Origins, I knew I wanted Rebirth, and my debate was do I get the normal hardcover tpb or do I go all out and get the Absolute Green Lantern Rebirth? Of course the "all-out" cynic in me chose the Absolute edition because of all the extras included and the larger size of the book compared to the normal size tpb's, which meant larger panels for my eye candy. I have to say the story of Hal Jordans rebirth is awesome and the art and colors really pop out at you. This is a great place to start for new Green Lantern fans who havent read anything previous and want to get into it.
