These things are all totes true but here's what else you need to know about this little

treasure. This comic follows a story that (as of now) doesn't occur in the animated episodes of Adventure Time featuring Fiona and Cake. In this volume, fans of FiFi and Cake will enjoy lots of "screen time" with the Ice Queen, Prince Bubblegum, Marshall Lee, and Lumpy Space Prince (OH MA GLOB! Check out his totally killer anime eyeeees!) Readers will also be treated to the first real appearance of the Flame Prince who is saved by Fiona shortly after his introduction and then spends the rest of the arc...just being generally adorbs as Fiona deals with her crazy friends and crazier enemy. At 176 pages, this book is a COMPILATION of six smaller Adventure Time comics which feature Fiona and Cake and the rest of Adventure Time's gender-swapped universe. You can purchase those comics individually but each comic is only about 20 pages and will run you 10-20 bucks. Don't do it, dudes! Why pay anywhere from 60-120 greenbacks when you can buy THIS volume for \$16 and get the whole adventure at once?!?!?! There's been some squinty-eyed doubters claiming you can get this for \$10 at any bookstore. Naw, bro. If you see THIS book for \$10, you send it my way. To be fair, this cover (featuring Prince Bubblegum, Fiona, Marshall Lee, and Cake floating in the clouds) is the same cover as volume 3 of the individual comics, so I see where the confusion comes from. But check your page count, friends! If there's a downside to owning this compilation over the individual comics, I guess it would be the loss of different cover art. All the cover images (including alternates, 'web exclusive', and convention covers) ARE IN THE BACK OF THIS BOOK! But they're shrunk down, sometimes as small as 4 on a page. Sooo...if you're picky about that, I guess...sorry? But for real, dudes! Buy this comic compilation if you got a mad hankering for more Fiona and Cake (surrealously, where's the love in the form of a spinoff show?) You'll get the full/new story arc with your favorite gender-swapped characters, meet the really hot Flame Prince, get all the cover images in the back pages and even the extra mini comics that were printed in the original volumes! As a long-time fan of Adventure Time, and someone who is familiar with the concepts of fanfics, and genderbends, I was totally stoked about the Fionna and Cake episodes AND the fact that they would be getting their own comics! The comics read exactly like what you'd expect of a genderbend fanfic, what with the romantic teases between the characters. Natasha Allegri's art is so stunning and stylish, but she's not afraid to go for silly expressions or panels. I'll admit that her speech bubbles can be a bit difficult to read, but I appreciate the hand-written typography that lends itself to the gentle, fantasy setting of Adventure Time.

Half of the book are the first four issues of the Fionna and Cake comics, and the other half includes a variety of art such as incentive covers, concept art by Allegri herself, and bonus comics from the end of the individual issues. It was such a treat to see how Allegri applied these then silly doodles into the show comic's "canon" (like Prince Gumball using Flame Prince for his oven). I also definitely recommend getting this hardcover version instead of the regular paperback compilation because the enlarged pages and additional content just looks SO good here.
