Issues 5 and 6 - After Waid was rudely interrupted by the latest event, he can now get back to telling his story. Hydra figures since they didn't get the Axiom drive, why not just get the information from Coulson directly? Also, Grant Ward is now introduced into the series. A new event, a new volume 1.
