Ok so this volume picks up where Akira is coordinating a rape of the girl who nearly raped Mizuki. Mizuki stops him in time (so there you go no actual rape!) and realizes that Akira feels like Mizuki must think he's such a wimp that he can't even protect her. Aww. They are

officially going out, but Mizuki still has her own issues to deal with. Apparently she doesn't mind being a 'Prince' at her school, but she doesn't want people to think she's a guy, just a really cool girl. The problem is that Akira is cuter than any girl and when they are together he's often mistaken for a girl and Mizuki for a guy. Actually Mizuki's 'issues' are getting worse, she's running out on Akira, crying and feeling sorry for herself.
