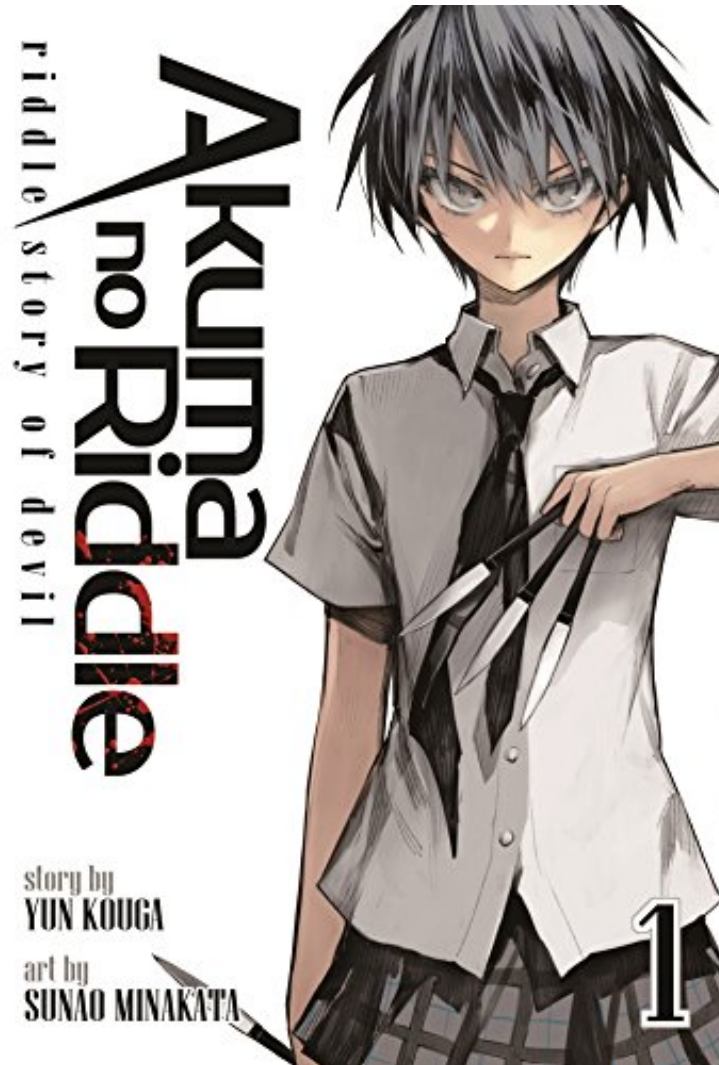

The rest of the book delivers those same beautifully drawn lines, and the artwork is all in all spectacular. There is quite a large cast of characters, all of them introduced rather rapidly, and most of them are

female. Despite this, they all have their own aesthetic differences and I had an easy time telling who was who. The story itself is very exciting. The basic plot is a take on the classic "killing game" setup - in particular, 13 school girls are all transferred into the same class. Twelve of them are assassins and the remaining one is the target, but nobody actually knows who the target is. Things get interesting when one of the assassins decides to switch sides. Characterization is pretty good here. There are a just a couple characters who so far don't seem to be more than cardboard stand ins, merely there to fit a role. But contrastingly, most of the other characters are compelling and interesting and realized. Apparently there's an anime version too, I've heard most people don't like it.
