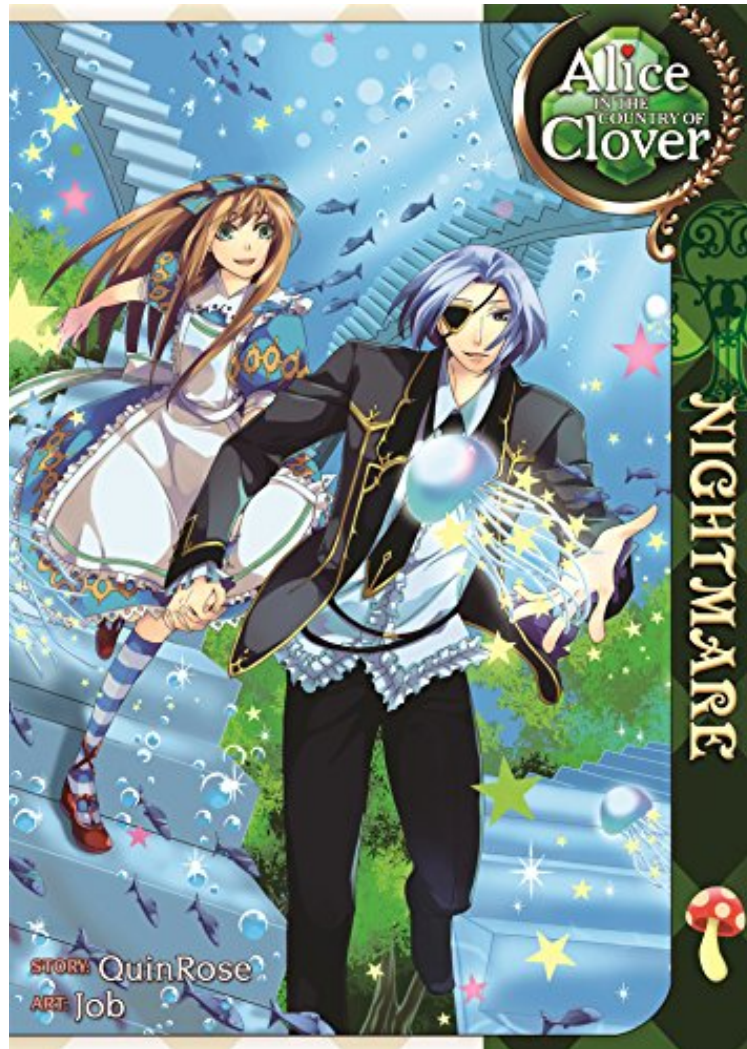

Also, the inking was kind of hard wobbly to read I won't complain too much because the art isn't drawn bad it just appears to be drawn in a different kind of style from normal. SmithI've collected all the QuinRose "Alice" books so far, but if I'd seen this one before I ordered it, I would have skipped it. It's that bad. I buy this series for the art as much as for the stories, and this one failed on both accounts. The characters are nearly unrecognizable, and Alice acts in ways that are inconsistent with the other books. There's a germ of a good story - Nightmare loses his powers when he actually feels good - but they don't do enough with it. Nearly a third of the book is a "Crimson Empire" story. Honestly - if I wanted "Crimson Empire," stories I would buy the "Crimson Empire" books. Shoving them in our faces when we buy "Alice" books is really annoying. And the characters in that story are COMPLETELY unrecognizable. All in all, a real fail. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
