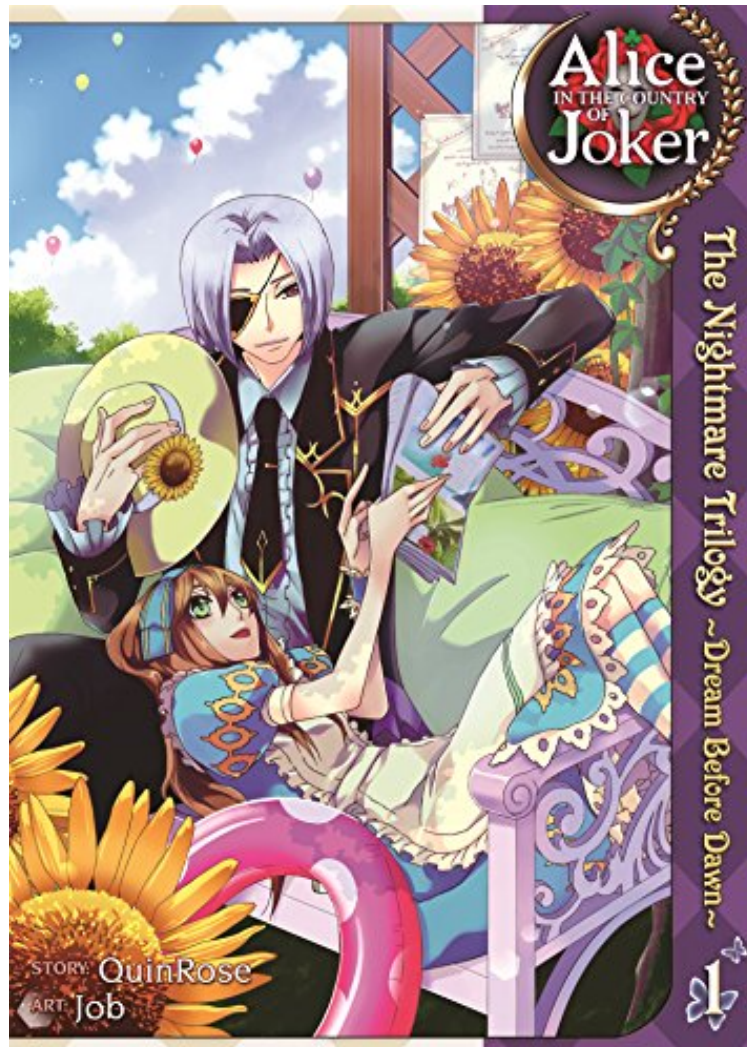

Unlike many manga artists that have a refined style and are consistent in the art quality, Job is neither refined nor consistent. What I

have against Job is the sloppy lines and shading that make unrealistic, unattractive characters. It kills me because QuinRose made such a good story which gets overshadowed by the poor art quality.
