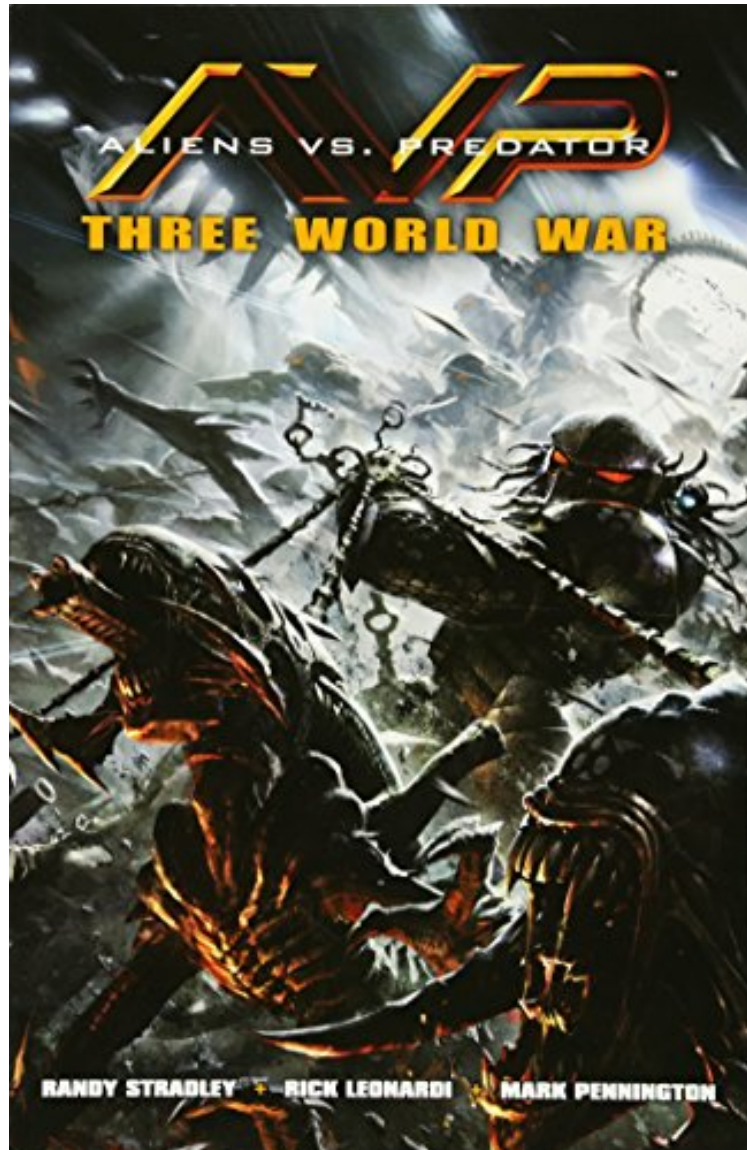

He later went on to become business partners with Mike Richardson, who founded Dark Horse Comics in the 1980s to focus on movie-licensed comics. Some of the published credits of Randy Stradley include The Heart of the Rebellion (Star Wars: Empire, vol. 4), Star Wars Jedi Council: Acts of War, Star Wars: The Bounty Hunters, and Star Wars Crimson Empire: Council of Blood, vol. 2. The author lives in Portland, Oregon. Rick Leonardi is a comic book artist who has numerous credits with Marvel and DC. Born in 1957, he started working at Marvel after graduating from Dartmouth College in 1979. Leonardi is partly responsible for designing the black-and-white Spider-Man costume that led to the creation of the villain Venom. Among his many credits are runs on Nightwing, Batgirl, Cloak and Dagger, Superman, Suicide Squad, and Uncanny X-Men.
