The 4 issues included are all individual stand alone stories. The first issue features the Vision. He talks to Ulysses as he's trying to decide whether to preemptively take out Kang before he becomes Kang or not. He then decides to track Kang down to his origin point in time. Next, we have a solo issue about Nadia Pym and Janet Van Dyne. Nadia can't accept that the heroes are fighting and tries to engineer a solution to Civil War II in her lab. I thought this was the best issue of the bunch. Third up is Thor. She talks to Heimdall about a time when the original Avengers team tried to stop Dr. Doom from invading a neighboring country. The flashback is all presented sideways across both pages which makes it difficult to read across the binding. Last is the annual. Ms. Marvel is reading Ms. Marvel fan fiction which each story by a different creative team. The first three stories are drawn by Adam Kubert and his art felt really rushed and sloppy. No where near as good as his older work. The annual was drawn by mostly terrible indie artists. From reading other reviews, I guess this is the last volume and the book is splitting up into 3 different series, Unstoppable Wasp, Champions, and Avengers. God, Marvel, how is any of your readers supposed to follow this? There are NO indications in this book. No wonder your books are failing.
