The writer does a great job of weaving subtle commentary by teenagers from the 60's on the social networking age and its fascinating lack of privacy and social skills. Each character has its own background, own struggles, dilemmas, controversy, and motivations, and each of them gets a chance to grow as the reader gets to know them.
