By Nils I like the premise of the "all new Xmen" series... the original characters being brought into the present. The first book was fun. The second was reasonably good. By this book, I've started questioning whether the author knows where he's going with the story... it meanders a bit into various complications, without having a feeling of a clear narrative direction. The characterization is also a bit inconsistent. The characters seem to be getting younger and acting like younger teenagers as the story arc progresses. In some ways they even act like preteens, not young adults. I suppose this is an attempt to appeal to younger readers, but it doesn't work for me.
