very clear; there's no smudging or misprints, and you can clearly read even the smallest print (for when people whisper). The binding seems sturdy and well put together, but I won't know that for sure until it's been around the block once or twice. So, Seven Seas Manga really seems to know their stuff; but back to the content. If you like High-School manga, then you should definitely try it out.
