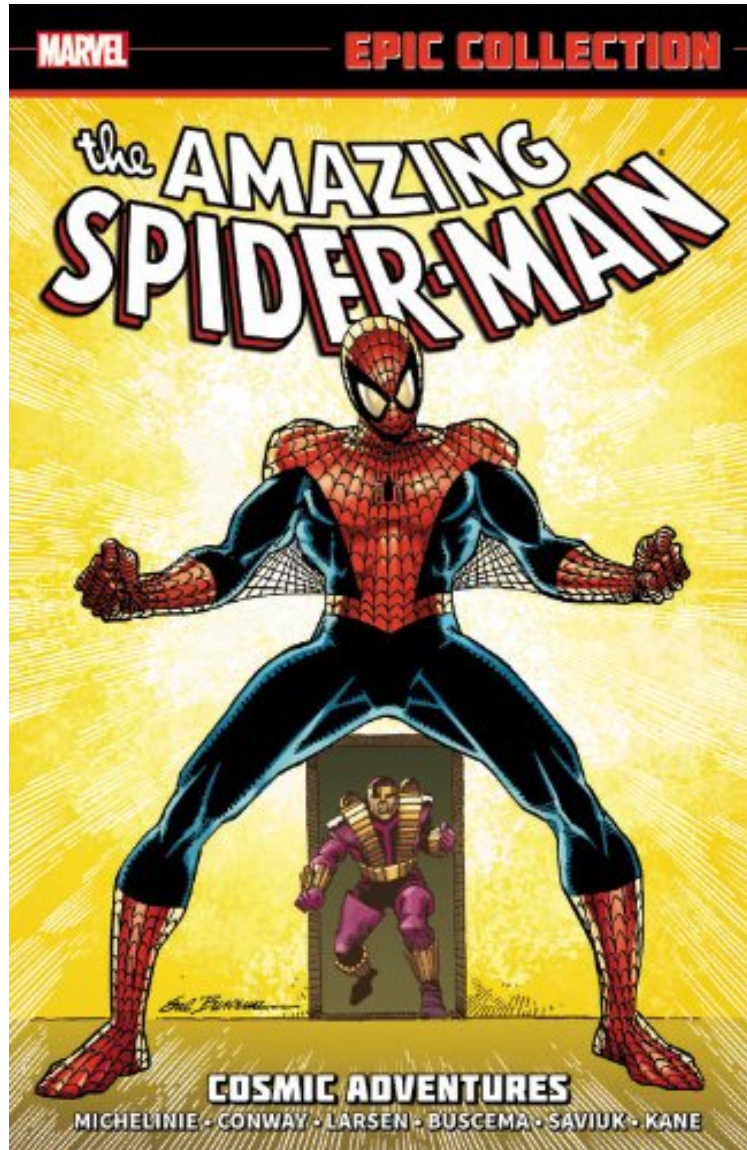

I originally read the Amazing Spider-Man issues of this collection (minus the annual) in the Amazing Spider-Man Omnibus by David Michelinie and Todd McFarlane, so I had an idea of what the story was but I didn't know the full story. The artwork is on point too and is well done. What made me like this book was the constant action, with Spider-Man facing off against villain after villain (Graviton, Magneto, Goliath, etc) and also the deeper story in which Peter has to deal with his new powers. The story more so delves further into the idea of "with great power comes great responsibility". If you like Spider-Man, then this is one book you need to have in your collection.
