I was around when the 1985 Amazing Spider-Man 9-issue index series was released. This book collects the Amazing Spider-Man index portion of the 14-issue Official Index to the Marvel Universe (Uncanny X-Men and Iron Man were spotlighted in that series as well). This book or trade paperback, like the 1985 series, lists the creator credits for both covers and interiors, supporting characters, villains, other characters, guest stars, and the synopsis. If you're a fan of a certain supporting character, guest star, or villain, it's easy to follow when it lists where they were last seen and where they appear next. In this new format, they've also introduced locations and items seen in the story. The trivia notes are very informative although very few entries featuring these notes need more research. Other than that, I HIGHLY recommend this! This book covers Amazing Fantasy #15 and Amazing Spider-Man #1-600 (this also includes "Vol. 2" when it was renumbered in 1998 and later reverted back to its original numbering in 2003.). As you can see below, only 170 out of more than 500 covers are displayed in full page size. I certainly would have picked different covers and I'm sure someone else would choose others still.
