Preacher, Hellblazer and Sandman by Vertigo comics/DC, Kingdom Come, The Dark Knight Returns, Watchmen, also by Vertigo comics/DC I think (except for Frank Miller's The Dark Knight Returns I believe), The Killing Joke, Old Man Logan, Runaways, Saga, Rat Queens, and (somewhat) more recently the Superior Spider Man if you like the titles I mentioned then maybe your tastes are similar to mine.... If you can snag a used copy of this at a low price then by all means go for it with the following cautions... there is absolutely no doubt that this is one of those titles where the heroine is primarily meant to be "eye-candy" for the heterosexual male comic book reader (which I'm guessing may will annoy the crap out of female comic book readers - and for good reason ... then again for all I know they may want to cosplay as the heroine too? I know some female comic book readers do that... no idea, to each their own and obviously each female reader will make up her own mind about this, but I can see how a female comic book reader might get annoyed at this comic) Despite that, the plotline was interesting enough to grab my attention ... I won't go too much into it since it would involve spoilers (I'm absolutely terrible at writing reviews that are spoiler-free).... unfortunately in my opinion the comic suffers from the same old drawback so many other comics do these days... they rush through far too much, far too quickly.. the writers and artists have painted an interesting world here that deserves a LOT more detail ... they need to slow the pacing down, go more into depth with the characters (both minor and major characters) and spend more time expanding the plotlines, even if it means extending the comic book series over a period of years.. which, in my opinion, they could have successfully done and maintained a profit on the comic if the writers and artists had only had more faith in it. Even in the foreword the writer admits to hastily putting the whole thing together and admits he could have and should have done a lot more with it. Now I feel bad about this review for bashing on the writer and the artists :P .. but still, it's a shame to see everything glossed over so quickly. Unfortunately that seems to be the trend with most comic books nowadays... churn out as much stuff as quickly as possible and pray something "sticks" and resonates with fans enough to make a profit on it as opposed to taking your time with a select few titles and giving them the attention they deserve... then again if the comic book industry did things that way maybe they'd be out of business for all I know! Again, if you can snag a cheap used copy of this go for it ... but I definitely wouldn't pay full price for it.
