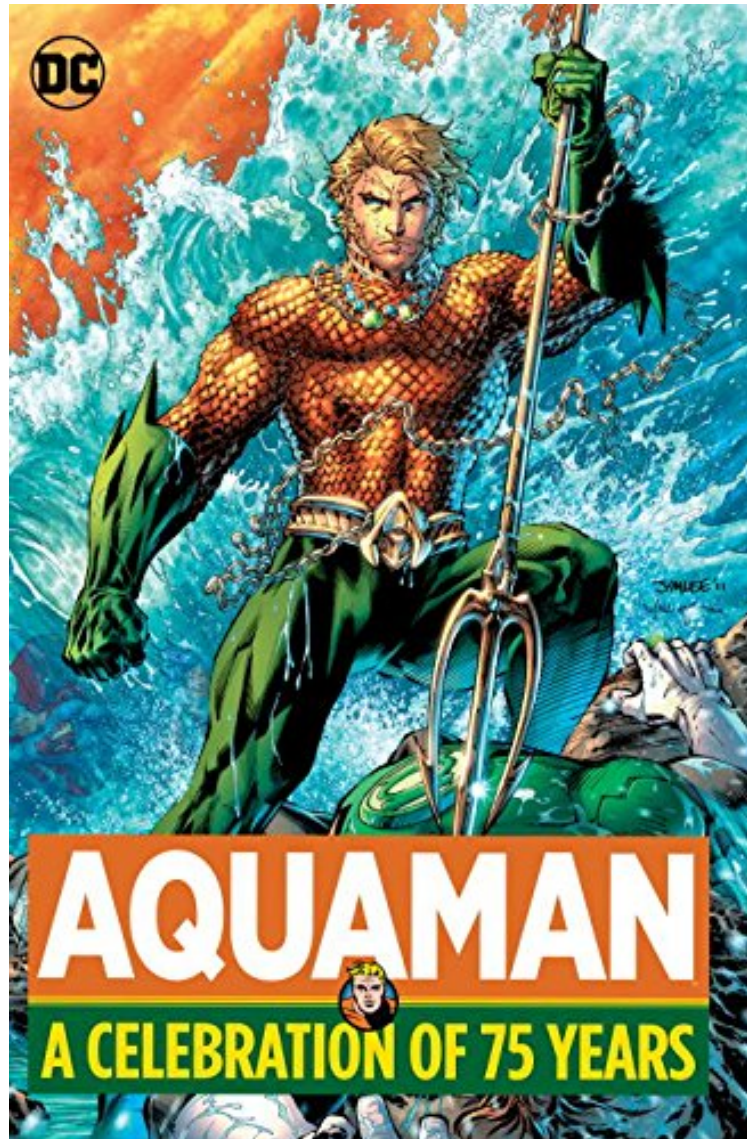

I really like the choice of cover art, and the binding. The stories collected here are also pretty eclectic. I thought there were a few too many Golden Age and Silver Age stories, those are not as fun too read, but they are very important to the history of Aquaman. Moments

collected here include the first appearance of Aqualad, the wedding to Mera, and the death of Aquababy. These were all vital stories in the collection. I liked the inclusion of an issue from the 1984 mini-series where Aquaman sports his blue suit. My biggest wish for this would have been more stories from the 90s and 2000s. I wish we got more Peter David, and more of the 2004 series out of this. I also did not think this collection needed the last issue from Cullen Bunn's arc, which was a terrible arc, and should not have had representation. I would have preferred a second Geoff Johns story, or something from Jeff Parker, or if they had waited- something from Dan Abnett's new Rebirth series. Also- the info sections throughout the book, were rather poorly written, and I think they could have been better crafted.
