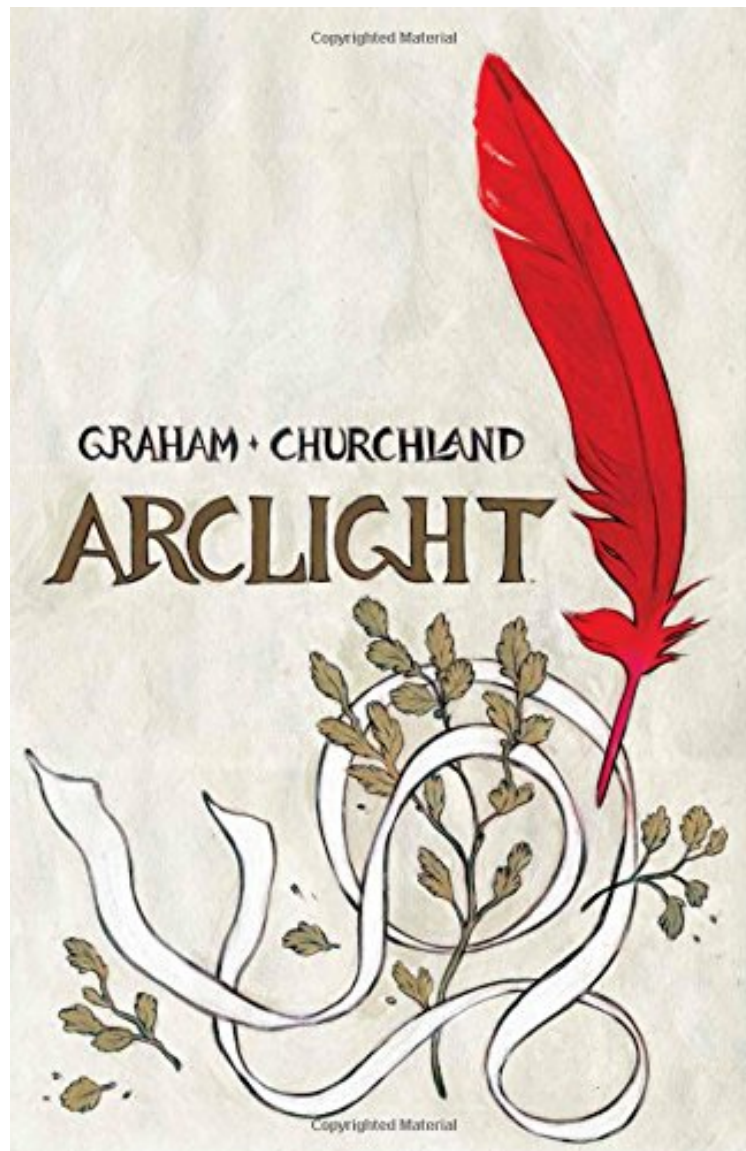

The art is really good and it just looks different from other comics, but I mean different in a good way. This is not a mainstream comic, and that is a good thing. I like a book that tells a unique story and does it in a

unique and creative way. The story follows a woman whose mind had been trapped in an alien body and the loyal knight trying to help get her consciousness back into her old body. The story is very interesting, and I like how Graham and Churchland tell the story. This is a book that makes you think. You might have to read it twice to fully understand everything that is happening and why the characters do what they do. I like it when an author leaves clues so you can figure the story out for yourself instead of just explaining everything in one big exposition dump. The world of Arclight is populated with all kinds of strange creatures, people from different Houses and magic users. Arclight was originally one story within the larger 8House series, and it is interesting to see how Arclight connects to 8House Kiem. I recommend reading 8House #3 Kiem if you like Arclight. I also recommend reading Mirror by Emma Ros and Hwei Lim, which was originally going to be part of 8House as well, and is another complex story outside of mainstream comics.
