I always liked the idea of Stephanie Brown as Batgirl, and I'm glad I finally got to read this collection. I like the dynamic between the characters, and the humor in the dialogue. The relationship between Oracle

and Batgirl here is great. I also really liked Stephanie's interactions with Damian Wayne (Robin). This series takes place during the time period right before the new 52, when Bruce Wayne was dead, and Dick Grayson was Batman. I really wish Stephanie's tenure as Batgirl had lasted longer. I also think Barbara Gordon was a stronger character when she was Oracle. If you have read any of the Rebirth era Batgirl series, this volume is pretty similar. I've only read a few issues, but Barbara Gordon in the current Batgirl comic is very similar in mannerisms to Stephanie Brown here. I think if you like that, you'll like this. I also like the supporting characters, Detective St. Nick, and Wendy Harris. The villains featured are also pretty interesting: Live-Wire, Roxy Rocket, Dr. Phosphorous, Catwoman, Man-Bat, Riot, Roulette, and more, make appearances. There is a lot of good stuff.
