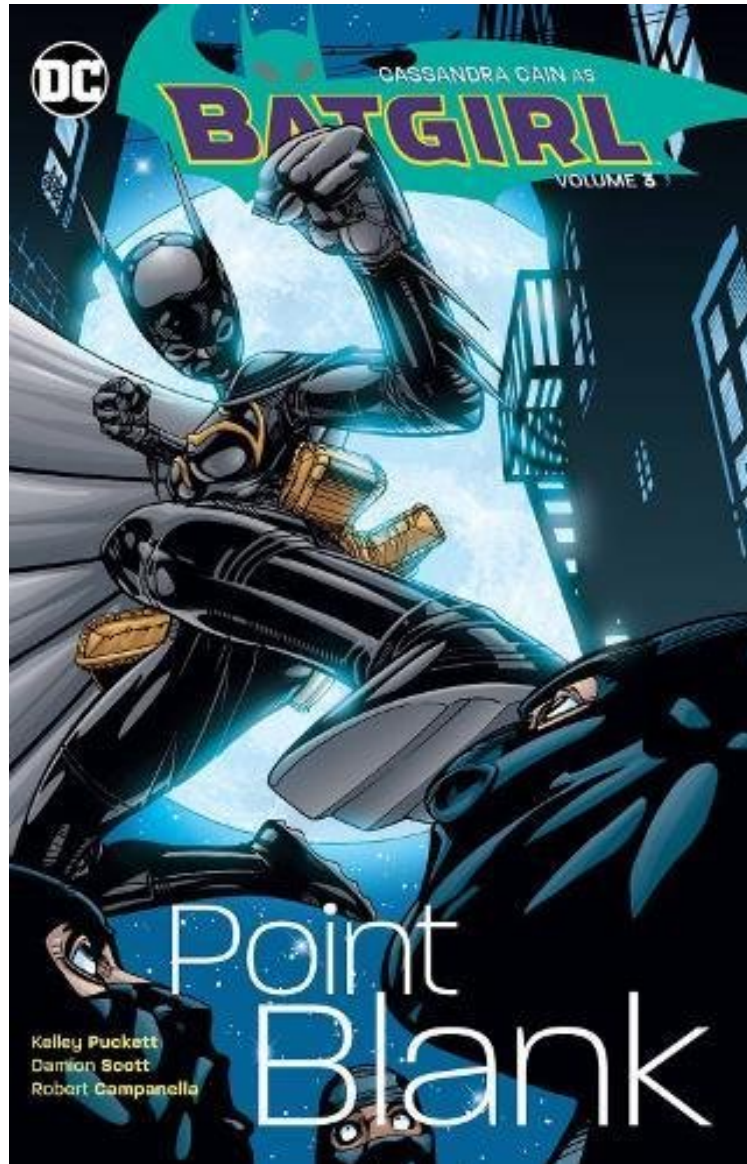

Now, I really dig this series, mainly how we get to see Cassie get more human and vulnerable as time goes on and she gathers friends. I also dig the art, which is rather cartoony, with overly large heads and hands at times. Now, I do have issues with this collection, as a lot of it is

based around the batman event Bruce Wayne: Murderer and Fugitive. Several issues deal with Bruce being gone or in hiding as the family tires to figure out if he killed someone, and if he didnt who did. Now these issues do do a fair job in my opinion to explain whats going on, but I have read that entire event, so I might be the wrong person to ask. Also the conclusion to that event is not contained in this volume, so if you are curious to how Bruce clears his name you'll have to check out those event trades. Another writer, Chuck Dixon writes an issue or so that involves some of his other creations, namely Tim Drake Robin and Conner Hawke green arrow. The story is fine, but its abit odd that Cassie takes a backseat in her own book.
