There was very little linking Batman's very challenges. The story was exposition heavy but didn't explain the elephant in the room (why Terry was following Dick Grayson's guidance rather than Bruces). It didn't touch on the events of 10,000 Clowns like I

hoped. I never thought of it before but Batman Beyond (Terry McGinnis), as other readers have said, does remind me of Spiderman. I enjoyed this comic book hero nonetheless, seeing as Spidey is one of my favorites. But definitely a recommended read.

A lot has changed in Neo-Gotham over the last year. Now balancing college, family, and crime fighting, Terry McGinnis still dons the red and black suit as Batman. Bruce Wayne is no longer chirping in his ear, however, replaced by the former Nightwing himself, Dick Grayson. One thing that never changes, though, is someone's always looking to bring the city to its knees. Called in to investigate the death of Mayor Davis, Batman and his allies sense foul play. When someone frees the inmates held in Davis pet project, the new Arkham Institute, those suspicions become dangerous reality.
