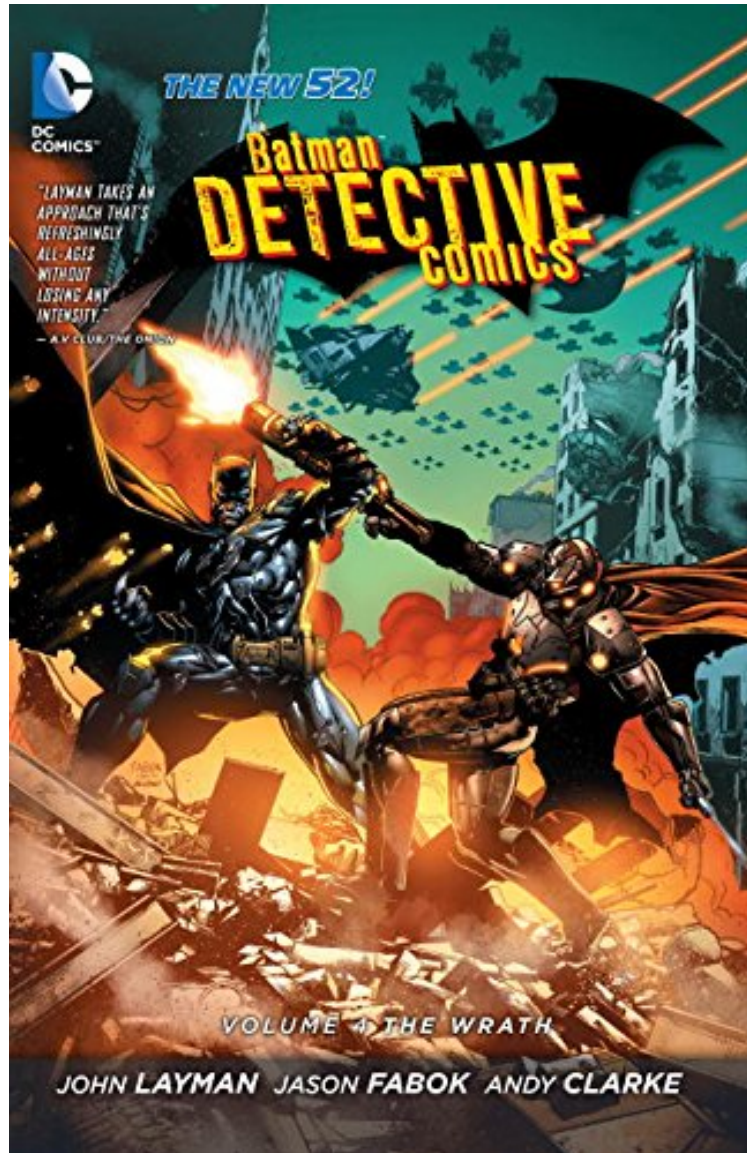

While there are numerous anti-Batmen like figures in the comic realm (including Prometheus, Owl Man, Lord Batman, etc.), Wrath feels to me like the most appropriate type for his rogue's gallery.
