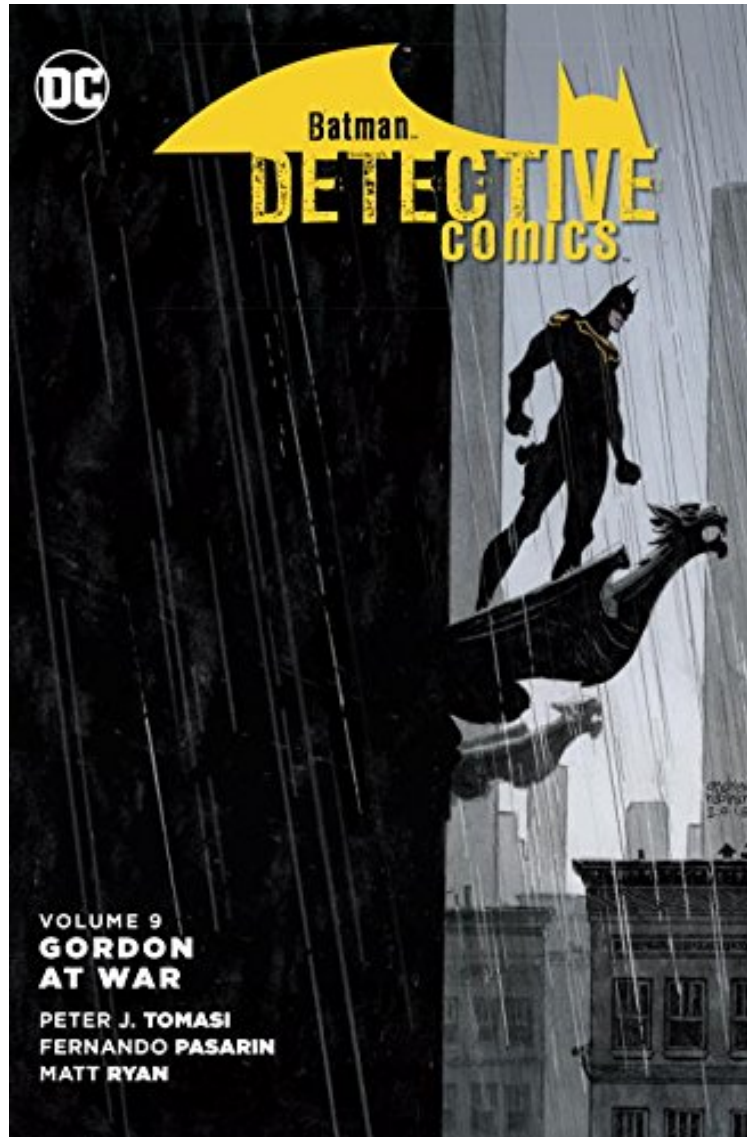

Peter Tomasi's back to his high standard of writing in this one. The book also has much better art with Fernando Pasarin taking over the art chores. His art reminds me of George Perez or Eddy

Barrows. This book winds up the Jim Gordon as Batman era with 2 main stories. In the first Gordon and Bullock hunt down a creepy serial killer. In the second, someone is hunting down Gordon's old Marine unit and he heads back to Afghanistan to investigate. The stories showcase the detective side of Gordon and work very well. There's also a short story with a rotating group of artists all of which have recreated old Batman covers. Lastly, is Batman: Rebirth. I keep hearing good things about Tom King but this story did not impress. Calendar Man now gets older and then rejuvenates with the changing seasons. Yeah, it was dumb.

As the new Dark Knight, former police commissioner Gordon must do what his predecessor did best: taking out crime in Gotham City.
