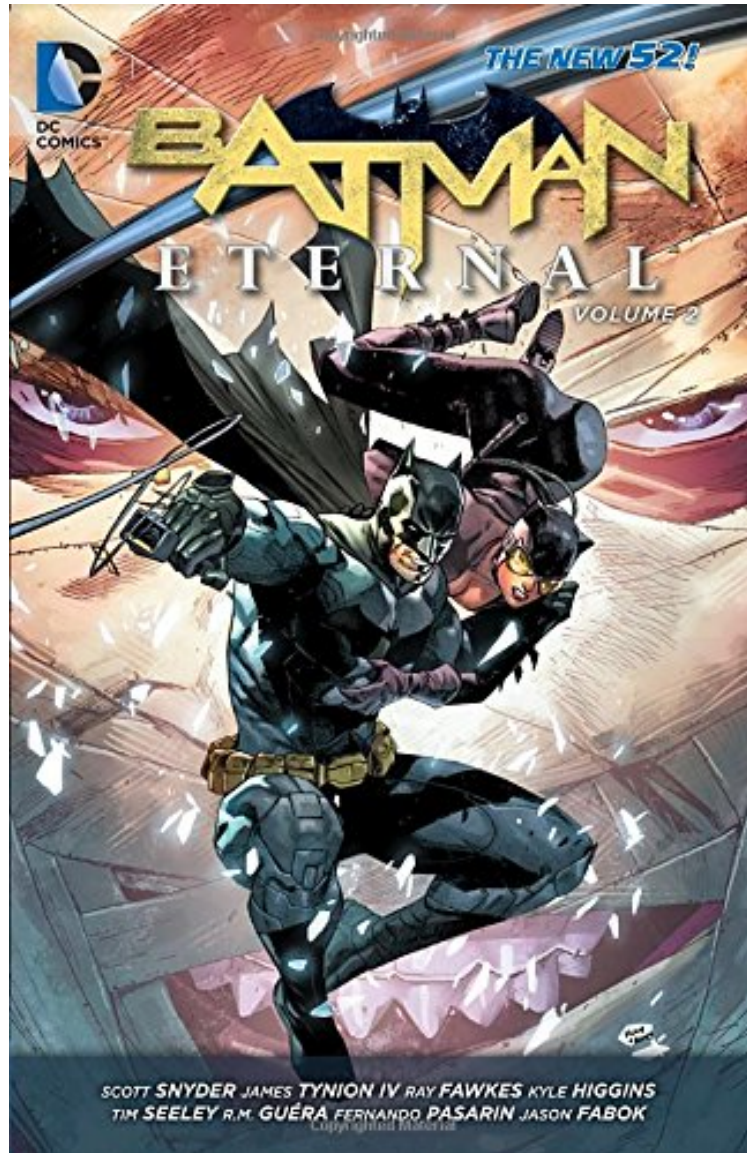

or penciled by one artist, it's a collaborative effort from some of the best writers and some of the best artists, and it really shows in this series. Great mystery. Great action. Great drama. Great art. Great writing. Great villain. Great supporting characters. Great side plots. All blending so perfectly in this three part epic. If you have already been following this series, then you know essentially where the story is and where it's going. It's a great continuation from the first volume and has me ready for next. It feels a lot more faster paced than the first one, probably less wordy, but that might just be me. Another New 52 Disappointment...HushBy Jonathan ClemThere is much to love in Batman Eternal Vol. 2, multiple conspiracies and events are occurring across Gotham City requiring the attention of not only Batman, but the entire Bat-Family sans the recently unmasked Nightwing. Alfred has been poisoned, the GCPD has been corrupted, and events are spiraling out of control. The constant action and developments should hold anyone's attention. But then there are the things you just shake your head at. For me it was the sudden reintroduction and almost amateurish use of a legendary Batman villain: Hush. I urge everyone to read the original Loeb/Lee story arc of Batman Hush, one of the all-time greats, and then compare it to the seriously under-developed and ham-fisted use of the character here. The New 52 has been notorious for retelling earlier brilliant DC storylines in newer but far less compelling ways. Sad to say but Hush has now been added to that list of disappointments. Overall if you are enjoying the weekly series of Batman Eternal and already own volume 1, then by all means buy volume 2.
