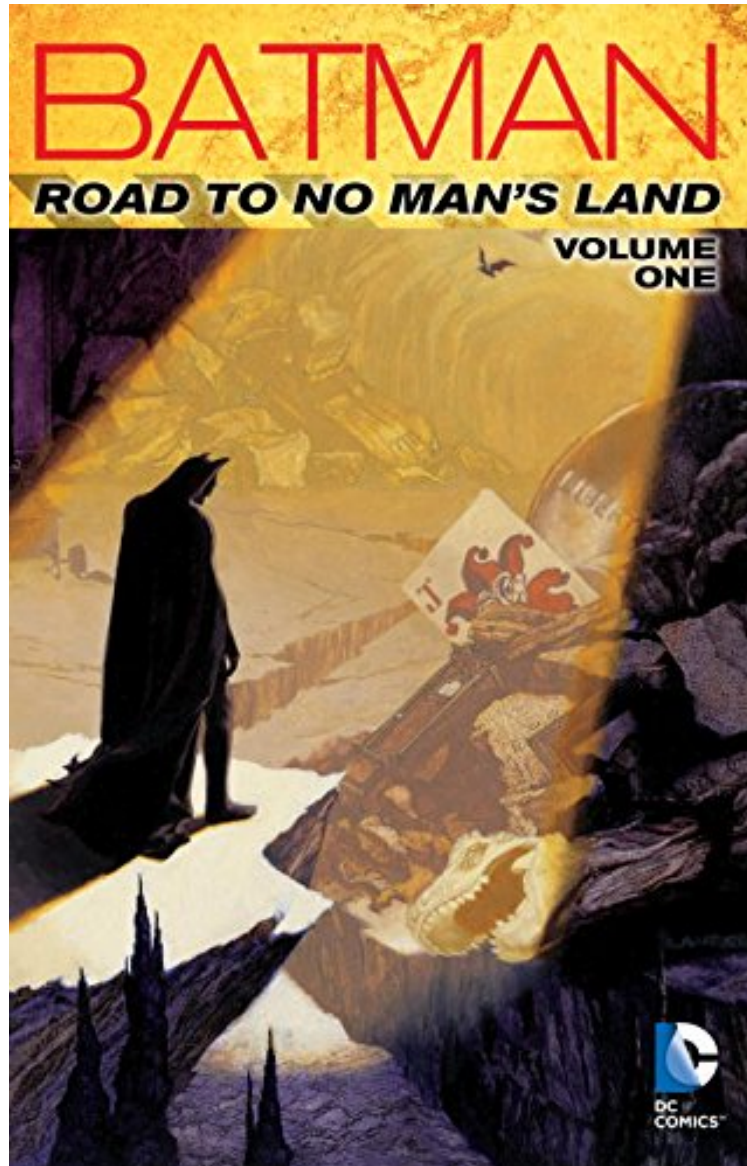

This is a direct sequel to

Cataclysm and serves as a prequel to No Man's Land; the book focuses on Batman's efforts to locate missing survivors and deal with a crippled city infrastructure. While Volume Two of the prequel series is a more direct prequel to No Man's Land (Batman attempting to convince the nation not to cut off the ruined Gotham, the city being sealed off and abandoned), this one is a great character study to Bruce dealing with a disaster for which there is no culprit. There is no villain to punish, only rebuilding to begin. Overall a great read and a must have for fans of Cataclysm.
