I was a bit nervous about this title (forced relationships can turn creepy real quick), but I'm glad I gave it a chance! I'm definitely getting a Butterflies, Flowers vibe from this, so I can see why Viz chose this as their next "It's totally not josei, look, would this Shojo Beat logo lie to you?" title. I laughed out loud quite a bit, and there were only one or two parts that

made me side-eye the book ("What's so wrong with looking out for someone who belongs to me?!"). For her part, Chiwa gives as good as she gets when they get into fights (which does happen often), but I can also believe that she's slowly falling in love with Hokuto. My favorite scene was when they go to a Love Hotel (cliche, yes, but DEFINITELY not cliche in how it plays out!), and I actually really liked the last chapter's message. I'm excited to watch their relationship develop! The characters are this story's strength - while the setup is a little far fetched, the characters' responses to it and each other are credible enough that you accept the premise and keep reading. It's definitely an adult story, but not raunchy and kept me interested throughout.
