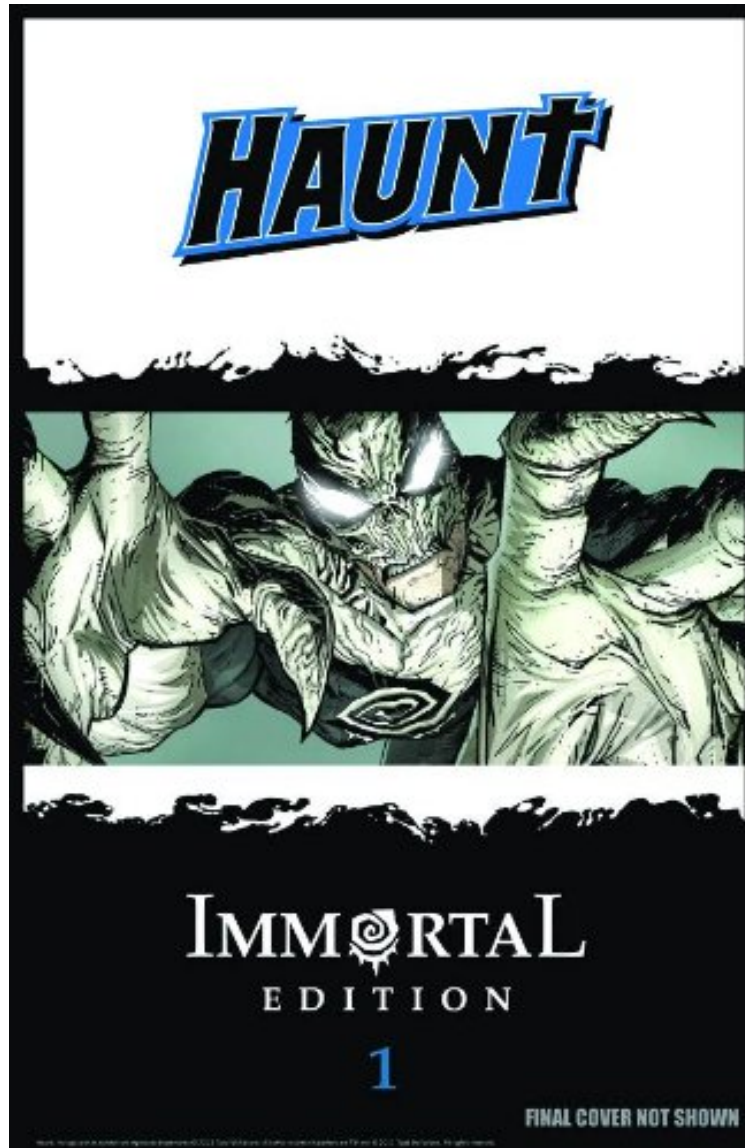

As I do love Spawn, I thought I'd check it out, get a feel for something new. It's didn't work, Haunt just doesn't compel me, it looks like a Spawn knock off but lacks all of the things that made Spawn into

the glorious experience that is Spawn. Instead what we get is an action comic with a little horror here and there but seemingly little character development. Another issue I had with the book was the fact that almost none of the characters seemed to have a distinct voice. They all felt bland, as if any line said could have been said by any character in the panel and you'd have had the same effect. More often than not I kept hoping that things would get better, that things would streamline and become more enjoyable but every time I was left with more "this is a derivative Spawn book" feeling and none of the characters made me care about their very existence. Maybe if you're a Kirkman fan you may like this, maybe, but for me it just felt bland and lifeless.
