I have an Android tablet, so the two-pages-at-a-time format worked fine on the fairly large screen. It would be even better to have a one-page-at-a-time option, to really see the detail, which is important for a GRAPHIC work, but companies seem slow to recognize this fact. It would be best to own the books, but for an instantaneous and inexpensive reading experience, this is fine.The story is great, and after the first volume I needed to
