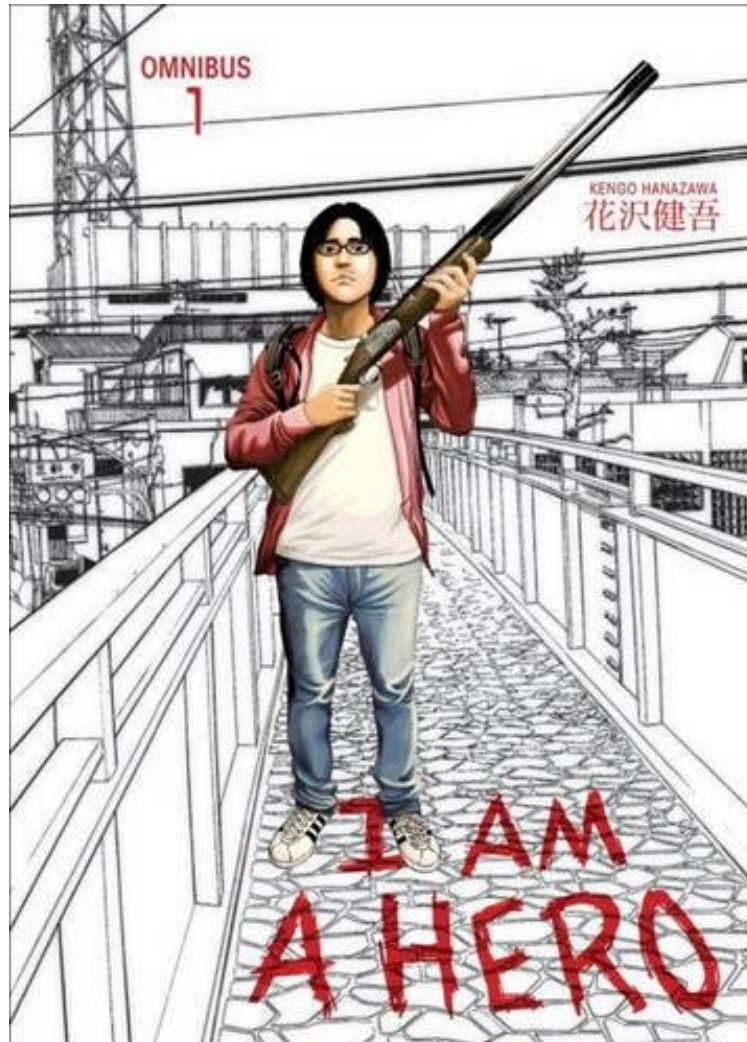

He's an anxiety-ridden guy who longs to be a full-time, successful mangaka...and/or a Hero. Later, unlike most of us who harbor such dreams, he will find himself in a protracted situation where he has no choice but either to

be brave and resourceful, or die. "The worm turns" is one of the oldest of story tropes, and this manga does it up proud.
