(Tokita is the one who provides the age-change drug that allows Chikage to try being a teen idol.) Chikage was one of the few people nice to him, which establishes the foundation for their friendship now. Its a surprising start for whats normally

a lighter-toned series, and it works well as almost a stand-alone tale of what helps a kid survive bullying. As a flashback, though, it gives the sillier events to follow more depth. Chikage already has a rival in present-day, adult life. That's part of what spurred her choice to try youth over again. But now, she gains one as a teen idol, too. Due to contrived circumstances, she's in a competition with another girl to perform the same song and see whose CD sells better. Her producer encourages her with dance lessons and coaching, but he's got a secret of his own (just to toss in some family drama). In addition to some cute kids, a fashion contest is added, as young Chikage will also be judged on her outfit, which requires her to get shopping help from Tokita. This can be a kitchen sink manga, with anything and everything somehow fitting within its pages, but that anything can happen approach is part of its charm for me. It's certainly unpredictable.
