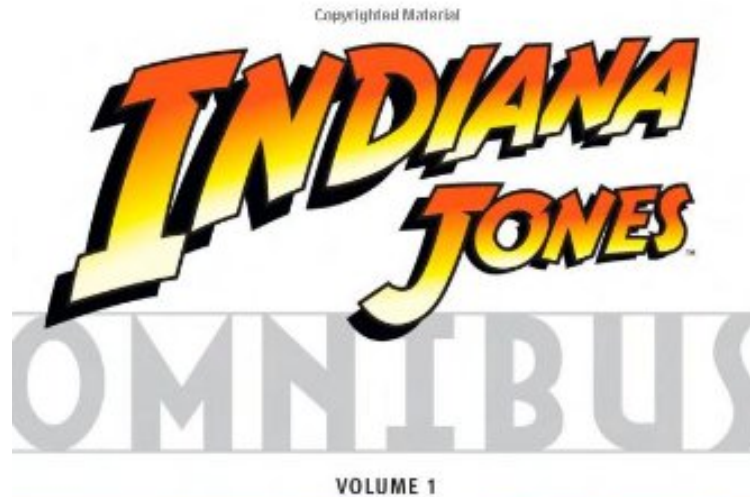

Thats EXACTLY what it is. The illustrations fit the stories perfectly, and the stories (for the most part) keep you moving along from all point over the globe. The stories do suffer from some clumsy transitions, where

suddenly Indy "is on a motorcycle and he never had one before" when 2 panels ago they were on foot. If you can overlook a few minor story inconsistencies, then this is worth the time. I loved it because it's bound well, printed on decently weighted gloss paper and the sharp colors look GREAT! It comes in at 350+ pages, so it's a good size tome, but still at a very readable size - a little larger than a regular paperback book. I travel a lot and these books are great travelers. They are simple enough that I can read 20-30 minutes at a time (waiting for boarding, luggage, takeoff, etc) but yet it will take you 5-7 days to get through one story. The fantastic original cover illustrations are included as well.
