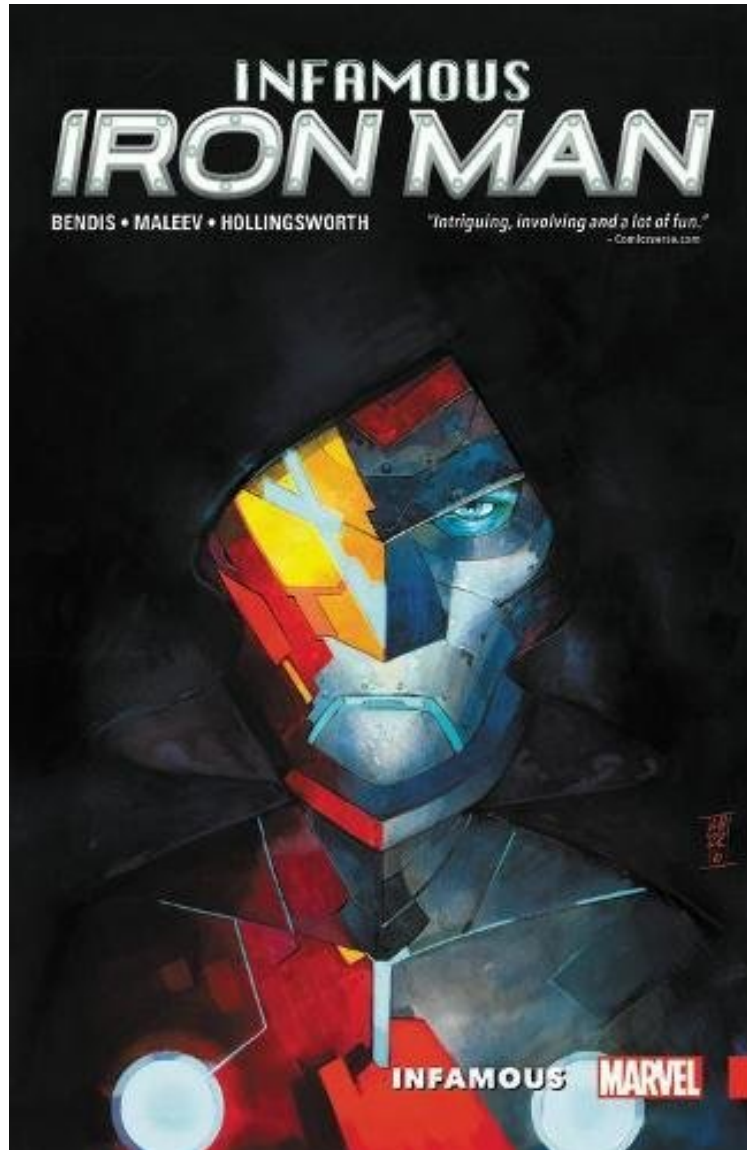

Doc Ock into Spiderman, Old Man Logan), and this work by Bendis/Maleev is the latest wholesale switch: Victor Von Doom has gone straight, and he has decided to replace Tony Stark as Iron Man (he is missing and presumed dead). Bendis ties this into the Secret Wars, which he wrote a few years earlier. Like the first Secret Wars from the 1980s, Doom was able to obtain unlimited power (he was God). In the modern Secret Wars, he collapsed all of the universes into one and created a new one (gone was both the 616 and the Ultimate universe....this is how we got Old Man Logan and Miles Morales into the current mainstream). In this volume, Doom states that his time as God was unsatisfactory, and that he has turned over a new leaf. It's very well done. The dialogue is stellar. I've been waiting for at least 10 years for Bendis to write the FF, as I thought his Reed Richards was the best interpretation. Instead, he is writing the FF by starting with Doom. Well done.
