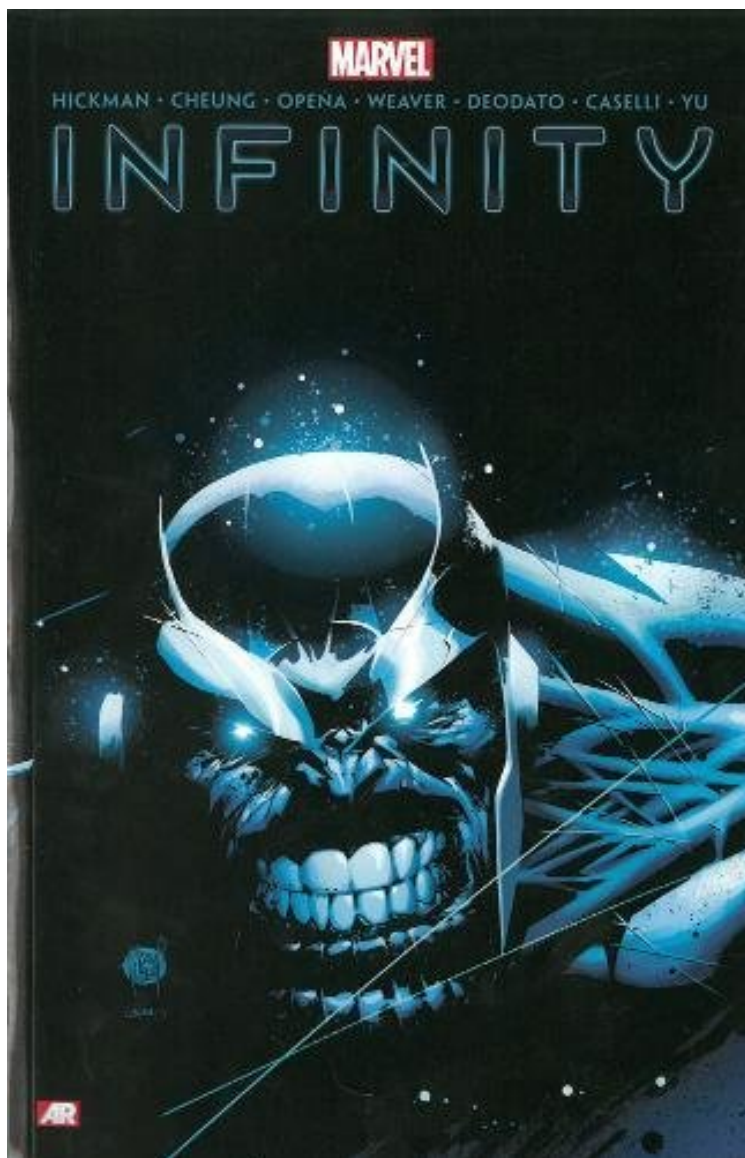

The action is not, IMHO, exciting enough and characterization mostly takes second seat to the plot. Not a fan of some of the characterization choices that WERE made in the story. Thanos is usually more complex a character, I felt his henchmen were a bit wasted and had potential to be so much more than the one note throw away characters most turned out to be, and I actually lost track of some characters toward the end. Had I been reading Infinity on an issue to issue basis, I'm not sure it would have held my intrest. However, as a TPB, I had fun reading it. Let's see how it stands the test of eventually being re-read.
