The story is a bit weak, but (sort of a spoiler alert) because it ends with only a minor victory for the heroes, it is salvaged a little. In this trade, we are introduced to Riri, a 15 year old African-American female who is enrolled at MIT. She has built her own Iron Man suit (Iron Lady? Iron Maiden?). While I applaud Marvel for adding to the diversity of its lineup of heroes, the planning, plotting and writing behind this was inadequate (so far). Unlike strong female characters like in Saga, Lazarus, Velvet, Fables or Powers, Mr. Bendis has not done the most important thing with a new protagonist - make them interesting. By Ian McKee I gave this four stars, but I'm not sure I'd recommend it to anyone, if that makes any sense. Bendis full on verbal vomiting mode here. everyone just keeps on talking, rarely adding new information compared to the amount of repetition. The plot is also really scattershot, with the Mary Jane and Riri subplots jumping in and out with no real purpose for anything. The main plot with Tony isn't any better, with a month long time jump just kind of out of nowhere and a stupid undercover bit that doesn't go anywhere at all. The art is really the highlight of this volume. It does have its weaknesses, I personally don't care for the male faces all that much, but it's still quite pretty. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Disappointing Mess. By Baz Sabotage Bendis can be a bit hit or miss and I would definitely put this in this "miss" column. First off, the cover suggests Mary Jane plays a central role, coming into Tony's life and shaking things up much as she did for Spider-Man. Nope, she's barely in the book and barely interacts with Tony, and her entire role could have been filled by literally anyone. I'd rate MJ among my top Marvel characters, but I honestly don't see why her role wasn't filled by Pepper Potts. The plot we do have goes literally nowhere... the resolution so unsatisfying that I sat down to write my first ever review because I couldn't figure out how else to deal with my frustration. There's so much great War Machine stuff here and Riri promises to be an interesting character, but... this was solidly a mess.

Something is rotten in the house of Stark, and Tony must delve into the nooks and crannies of his international organization to root out the answers. But what will he find?
