The writing is very good and shows the amount of time and quality that DC has spent on their craft. I only wish that the art had been more adventurous in terms of style. This is the first of a series of new HELLBLAZER editions starring Vertigos longest running antihero, John Constantine, Englands chain-smoking, low-rent magus. This first collection is a loosely connected series of tales of Johns early years where Constantine was at his best and at his worst, all at the same time.

About the Author Born in 1954, Jamie Delano has made a diverse, cross-genre contribution to the comic book medium, scripting over some 25 years both original works (World Without End, Tainted, Ghostdancing, Hell Eternal, Cruel and Unusual, Territory, Outlaw Nation) and publisher-owned properties (Captain Britain, Dr Who, Night Raven, Hellblazer, Animal Man, Batman, Shadowman). He is currently practicing for retirement, living in semi-rural England with his partner, Sue. John Ridgway is a British comics artist whose work is immediately distinctive for its unusual realism coupled with a delicate, sketchy pencil line. Ridgway has been responsible for creating the look for a number of series, including Hellblazer, and has worked on iconic characters including Doctor Who and the Incredible Hulk. He was also the artist chosen to depict Judge Dredd without his helmet for the first and only time in the character's history.
