The events in this arc do depend on some stories that preceded it, but this can be read without it as the "Tale of the Dead Man" does a good job of showing how Judge Dredd began to have doubts about the Judge system which culminated with the "Letter to Judge Dredd" story that takes place before the progs in this collection. The Necropolis storyline is a solid piece of writing, and the artists involved did a great job. It has aged well in my opinion and still looks great. My only complaint about this collection is more a choice on how the progs were decided- I think that the "Dead Man" series would have been a good fit with this

collection and followed into "Tale of the Dead Man" pretty well. Its absence does not detract from the story, though I think it would have been a good addition to the Necropolis dominated case files 14. As for the quality of the book, it is good. This is one of the case files that are printed on good quality glossy paper, as opposed to the telephone pages-like paper in the older, more bulkier case files. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Meanwhile Judge Dredd has been exiled to the harsh wastelands of the Cursed Earth and time is running out for the citizens he once swore to protect.
