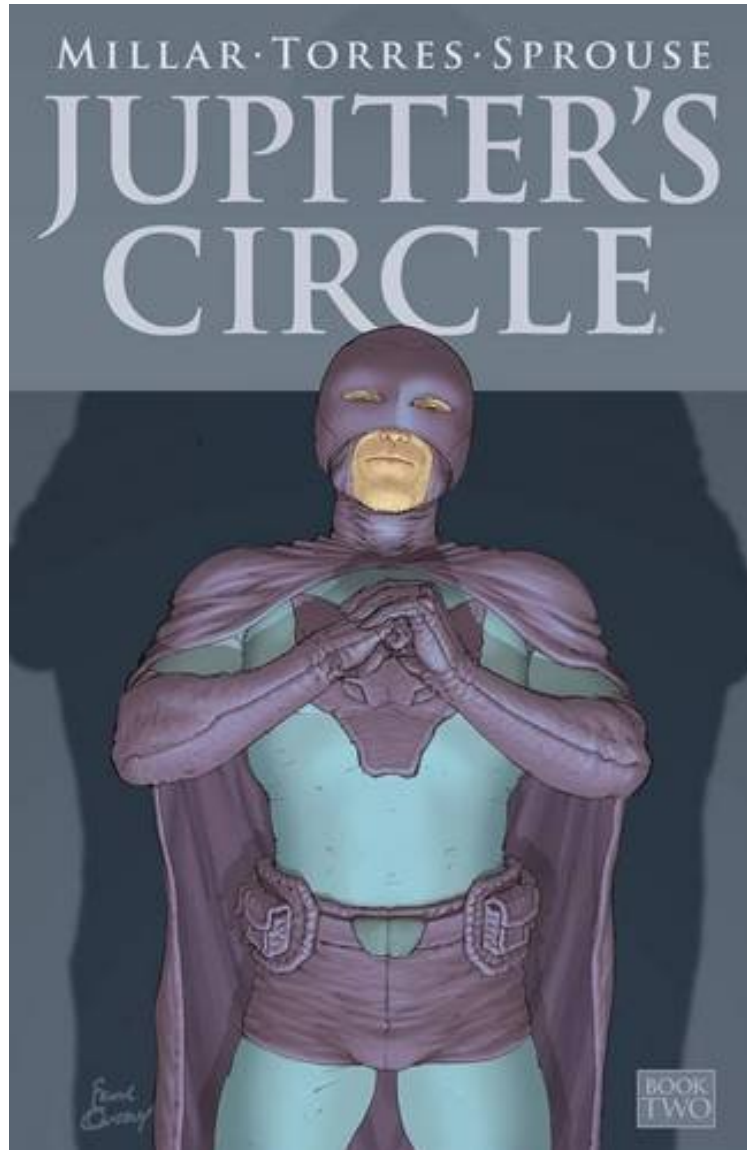

move on (Harvey Pekar figured this out 50 years earlier than me and at a younger age). The characterization, dialogue, plot and art are all first rate. The motivations make sense, and none of the plot devices seem over contrived or corny. In the first volume, we had appearances/references to L Ron Hubbard and J Edgar Hoover. Early on in this volume, one of the heroes spends a little time with Keroac and Burroghs. It's a nice counter-culture moment. Ayn Rand makes an appearance too (Millar does a good job of having her come across in a way that I think is accurate - which is interesting because I still don't know if that makes him a fan of her or not). For those that haven't read the first volume or Jupiter's Legacy, I strongly urge you to do so.
