(Also, I am a big fan of both Mark Millar and Dave Gibbons.) Need I say, I was not disappointed?The comic series/graphic novel retains the basic premise of the first

movie, but takes a considerably different route to get there. This means you basically get a different, and just as enjoyable story during your journey to the 'happy ending', as well as some different characters. Eggsy does not become as suave and sophisticated as Tatum Egerton's portrayal in the movies, although he does learn how to be -- or at least pass as -- a proper British gentleman; think Connery or Craig, not Moore or Brosnan. Key plot points are the same, but more attention is paid to Eggsy's training. And Mark Hamill is in the book as Mark Hamill, not some academic. Read it. You /will/ enjoy it if you liked the Kingsman movies. Or if you enjoy comics that are closer to Watchmen (which Gibbons also illustrated) than more typical superhero fare.
