As you would expect, this omnibus picks up where The Amazing Spider-Man Omnibus Volume 2 left off, with 1969s The Amazing Spider-Man number 68 and runs through 1972s issue 104. It includes the covers of The Amazing Spider-Man Annuals 6, 7, and 8, which were reprint issues. The covers of Marvel Tales 51

through 83, which reprinted The Amazing Spider-Man stories included here, are printed four per page. It also includes commentaries by John Romita and Roy Thomas, and additional artwork extras. The stories address subjects at the forefront of society at the time, including college protests, racism, prison unrest, and drug abuse. Several well-known characters make appearances including the Kingpin, Quicksilver, the Shocker, the Lizard, the Human Torch, the Prowler, the Chameleon, Electro, the Black Widow, Doctor Octopus, Iceman, Ka-Zar, and Kraven the Hunter. This volume includes several important events in the Spider-Man mythology: the death of Captain Stacy, the first appearance of Morbius, the six-armed Spider-Man storyline, and the reappearance of the Green Goblin in issues 96, 97, and 98 which were printed without the Comics Code seal due to the drug related subject matter. Those issues prompted a revision to the Code. The stories were written by Stan Lee and Roy Thomas, with artwork done by John Romita, John Buscema, and Gil Kane. I was a little disappointed that the book did not include the Spider-Man story from Marvel Super-Heroes 14, published during this period, and included in the Amazing Spider-Man Marvel Masterworks Volume 8. But that is a small oversight considering all that is included in this collection. If you are a Spider-Man fan or enjoy Silver Age comics, this volume is a must!

A wonderful omnibus with sewn binding and excellent reproduction of the original comics. The 920 page volume contains Amazing Spider Man issues 68 to 104 and annuals 6 to 8. What is unique about this volume is while earlier issues have been printed and reprinted several times in the past, most of the issues in this omnibus have never been reprinted before. Perhaps a handful have seen the light of day during the publication of Marvel Tales back in the 70's 80's but pretty much that's it. This volume also dove-tails nicely with Epic Collection Amazing Spider Man Goblin's Last Stand which reprints issues 105 to 125 and is currently available on in paper back.

06/01/17 Update: This is what happens when you really like Spider Man but are a big DC collector and never really delved into the mysteries of the Marvel universe. As the people who commented below point out, these issues are also available in the Marvel Masterworks series which is like DC's Archive series. They are also available in the Marvel Essentials which is similar to DC's Showcase Presents series which is published in an economical black and white newsprint format. The stories are also available in the Epic Collection series as color trade paperbacks.
