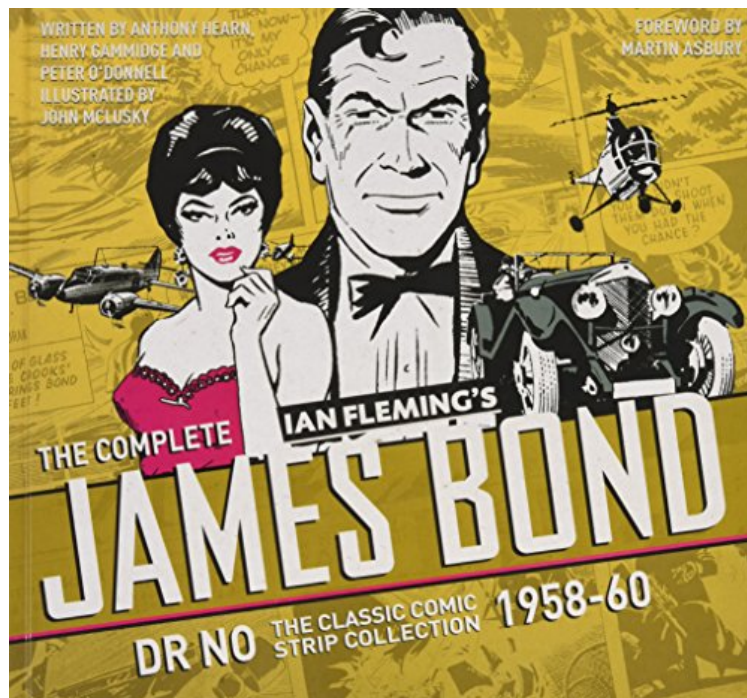

The 3rd VersionBy Stephen Vincent KemptonWhen Titan Publishing brought out the Spectre James Bond Collection last year I thought it was important to point out it's faults which I won't go into here. But now I think it is equally important to point out when a Publisher listens and corrects their problems.This volume presents two years of the British James Bond strips from Daily Express newspaper. These are six very faithful adaptations to six Ian Fleming James Bond novels. This is four years prior to the Dr. No movie in 1962 which made Bond a Giant Hit Worldwide.This is a 256 page Deluxe Hard Cover which prints the strips in sequential order from the very start. Three Daily strips to one Landscape Sized page. The printing is ultra sharp and looks beautiful.The art is all by British Artist John McLusky

who is very much in that school of fine line art headed by Alex Raymond. The six stories adapted are the work of three writers adapting Ian Fleming. The first story Casino Royale is by Anthony Hearn. Later Dr. No would be adapted by Peter O'Donnell who would become famous for his creation of Modesty Blaise. The other four stories here are all adapted by Henry Gammidge. This material has now been reprinted three times in three different formats. This is both the best version and the priciest. It was first reprinted in thin Trade Paperbacks. Then reprinted in thick Paperback Omnibuses. These are the best value but the least recommended, due to the drastic reduction in page size which makes them a challenge to read. They are the size of a comic book trade, but much thicker. While this volume does have an introduction by an British Comic Artist and Movie Storyboard artist it lacks some of the background and reference articles found in the two previous volumes about the history of the strips. This is my only real complaint. Highly Recommended for newcomers, previous owners must decide if they want to upgrade.
