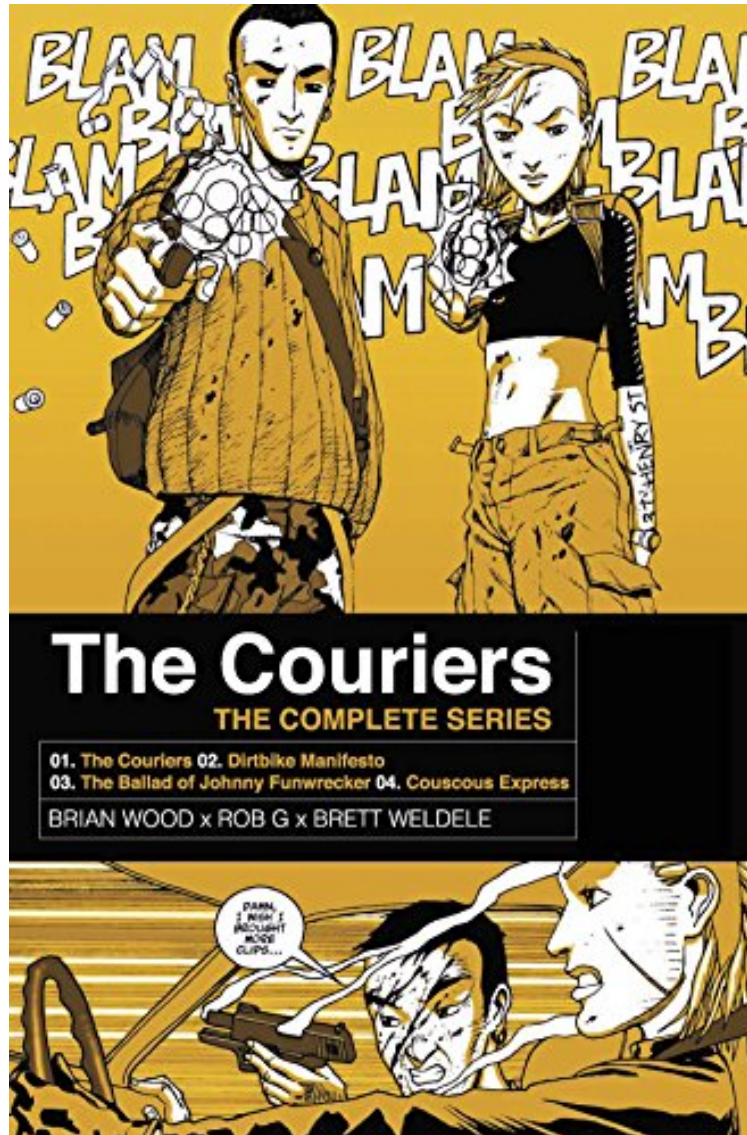

If their not expensive, they may be reprints from the golden or silver age, less satisfying than contemporary fare. This book is very affordable and is filled with lots of material. The book has a great sense of humor and a compelling plot. For those of you curious why the font for the Couriers is Helvetica and not Courier, the story takes place in NYC and Helvetica is the official font of the NYC subway. It's a great gift for young people moving to the city.

Collecting the complete four-volume saga, including the prequel graphic novel, Couscous Express, this epic story from 2002-2005 is the hyper-violent, tongue-in-cheek tale of mercenary bike messengers in New York City who do the jobs no one else will: the black market runs, the smuggling, the hits and the double crosses.
