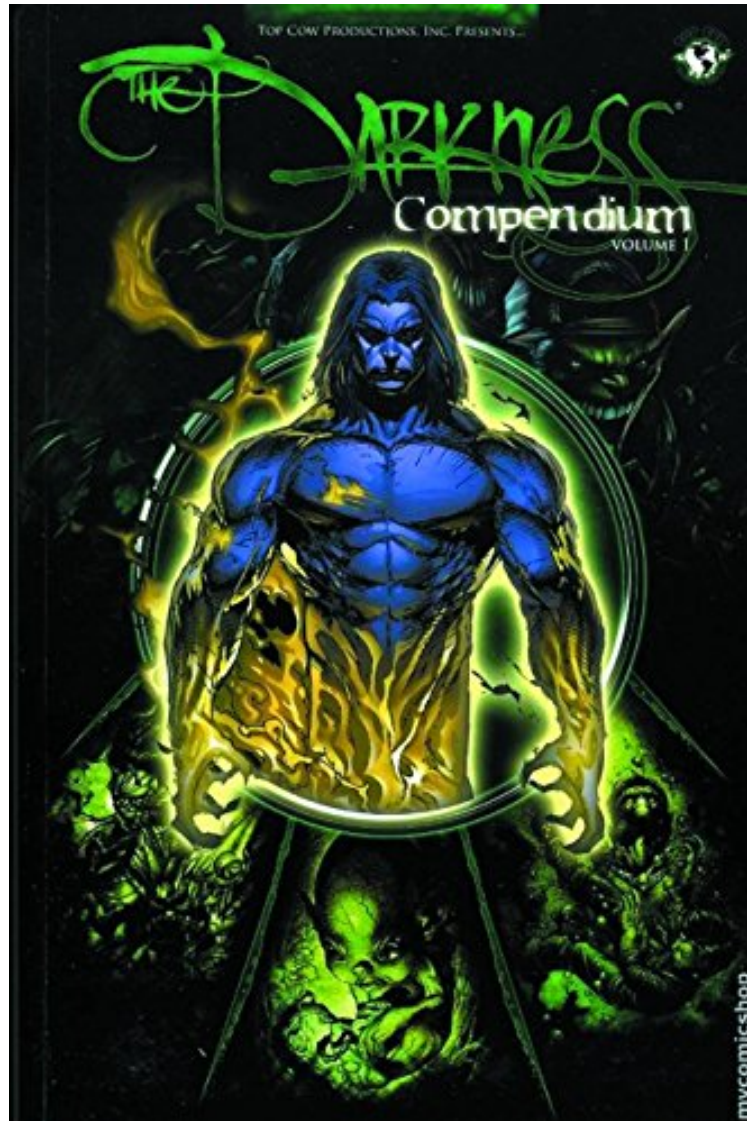

This was very upsetting and messed up the continuing story line. Second: A lot of the great art work and dialogue was lost in the fold of the book.
