of Flashes in one book! By Brian Reaves Mark Waid did a lot with the Flash, but this collection will probably best be remembered for the "Return of Barry Allen" storyline. This was well after the Crisis on Infinite Earths, and the sudden return of Barry gave Wally's story a happy ending at last...or so it seemed. The truth about this Barry Allen gave the series its best story to date, and pushed Wally to his limits. I won't give away the ending to it, but definitely don't miss this collection. It's a little weird though, as they break up the continuity of the story to throw in a Flash Annual "Bloodlines" issue that introduces a new character (as all the "Bloodlines" stories did in all the other comic titles), and then takes us to the resolution of the Barry Allen story. The collection also includes several great appearances by Jay Garrick and Max Mercury, along with a few other familiar faces early on. But the beauty of this collection is the final few issues, where Wally faces one of the greatest Flash villains of all time long before they diluted him and overused him in later series.
