Since the 1940s, Kanigher wrote and/or created more characters than nearly anybody else in the field, including Batman, Blue Beetle, Steel Sterling, Black Canary, Captain Marvel, the Flash, Sgt. Rock, the Haunted Tank, Wonder Woman, Lois Lane and innumerable war, horror and romance scripts. Kanigher scripted the Silver Age Flash's origin story in *Showcase* #4 and contributed several more tales to his subsequent *Showcase* appearances before finally returning to the character for an extended run as regular writer on *The Flash* in 1970.
