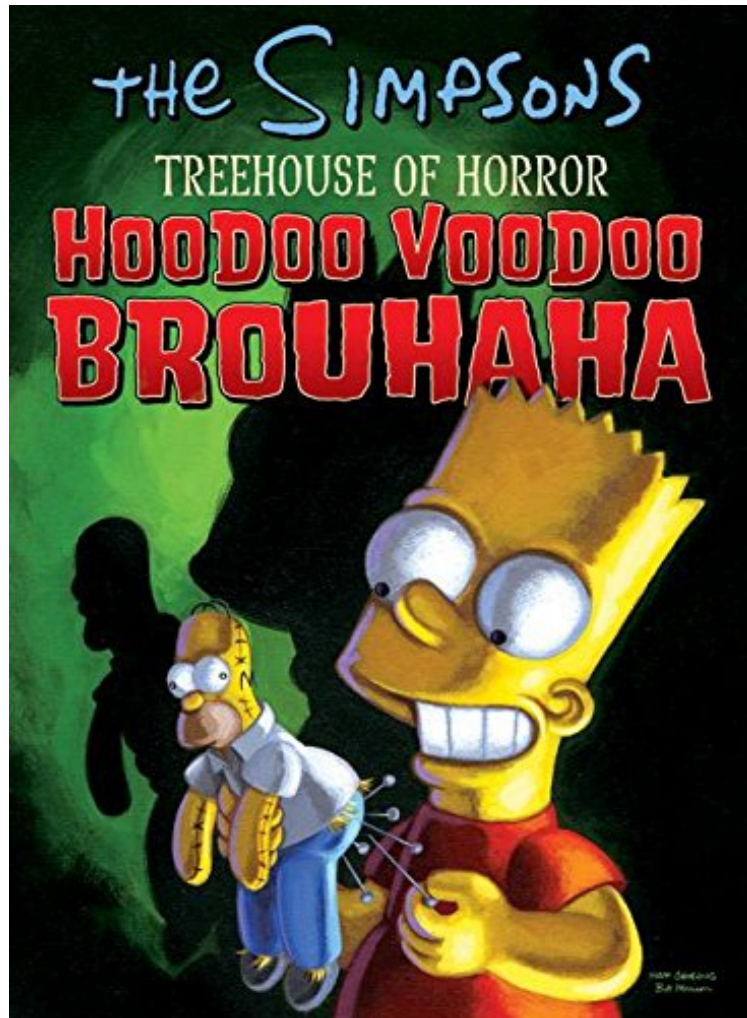

This was a very enjoyable book. I might even have been tempted to give it five stars if the artwork hadn't been so up and down. The one and two page items have the same aesthetics as the show, but the longer stories look mostly like fan art or cheap knock-offs. The characters are drawn with the wrong proportions and angles, and the style and palette isn't always consistent with the show. I found that it distracted from the otherwise enjoyable stories. I expect more professional consistency from a Simpsons comic book.
