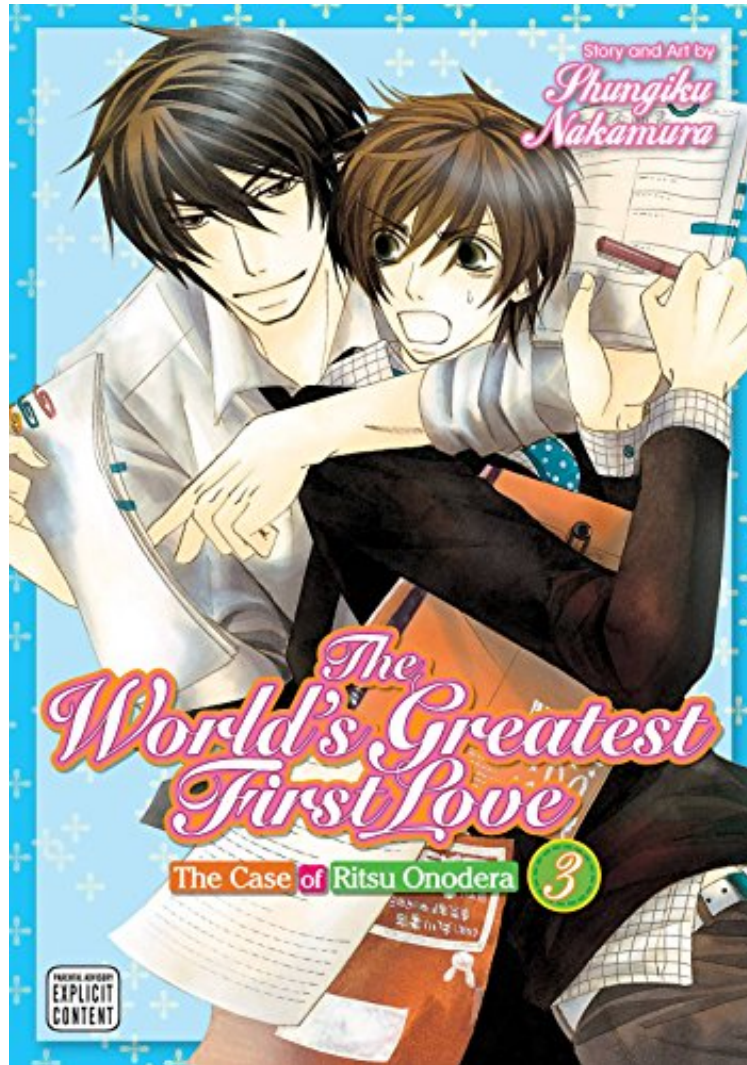

Ritsu's been assigned as coordinator for the anthology and is being hassled on both sides from the printers and the other Emerald editors. The first manga book he's edited is also going on sale and he decides to check it out at the bookstore which puts him in an awkward position with Yokozawa of sales

who also acts as an antagonist to their relationship. The second half of the book sets up the story of Kisa, the cynical baby-faced editor who sits next to Ritsu and his love interest, the beautiful Yukina who works as a part timer in the shojo manga department of a bookstore. Overall the book is well done. The translation is very readable with minimal usage of Japanese terms like san and senpai so it retains the feel of being in a Japanese publishing house while being readily accessible to the western audience. The quality of Ritsu's story is comparable to those of the first two volumes. Kisa's story is a bit of a change of pace as it's less exaggerated and satirical but serves as a nice counterpoint to the main story. Ritsu Onodera, an editor in the shojo manga department of Marukawa Publishing, has one arch-nemesis, editor in chief and hotshot boss Masamune Takano, the very same man who also happens to be Ritsu's first love! Though it hasn't been easy working under Takano, Ritsu has finally decided to do his best at becoming a proper manga editor.
