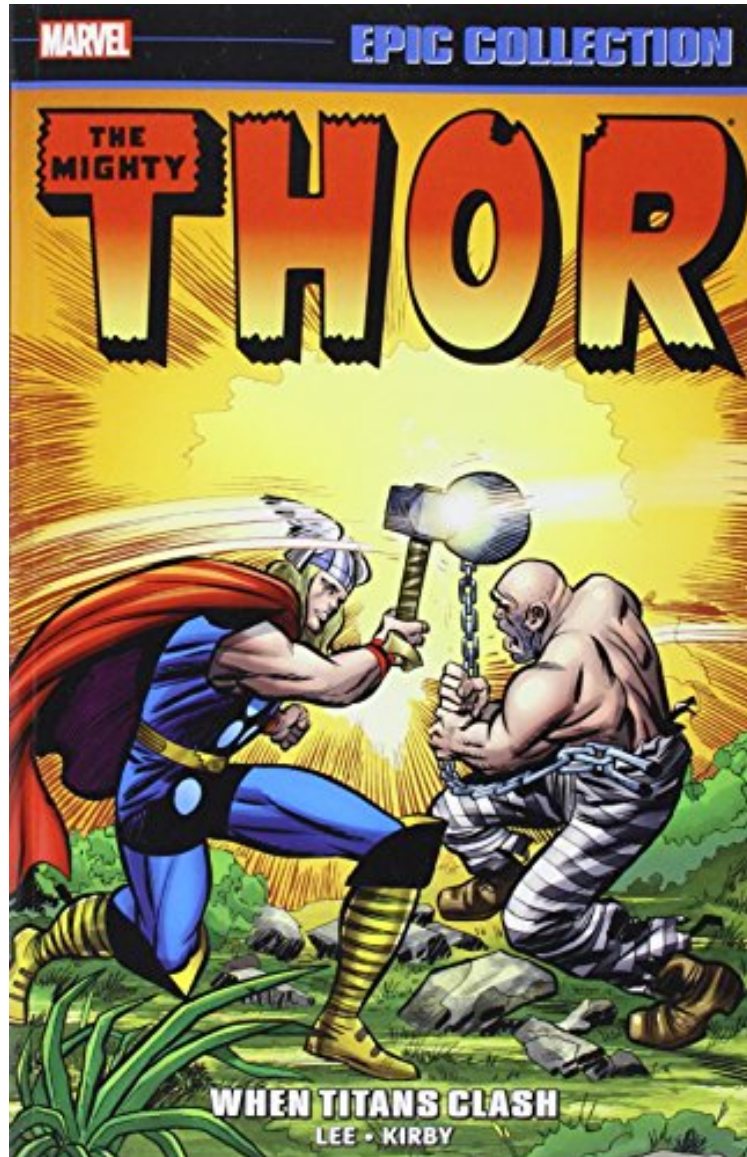

Epic indeedBy BarClayThe earlier Thor collection has material from the early days of Stan Lee and Jack Kirby, when it was obvious that Kirby's artwork was rushed and Stan Lee hadn't quite thought out who Thor would be. (Consider the prodigious amount of material both were churning out at Marvel at the time, and this is hardly surprising.)This collection, however, begins well into their best period. Kirby's artwork is now the mature and detailed style fans have come to love and respect. Kirby didn't just draw a face. He drew a character. Every major and minor character is unique. Only the faces in the crowd are stock faces. Lee was beginning to flesh out the drama and character of Thor. The juxtaposition of Thor and Hercules was clever. They aren't just two gods of separate pantheons. They are different men entirely.Like all the Epic Collections, you get a large number of comics on firm paper at a reasonable price.
