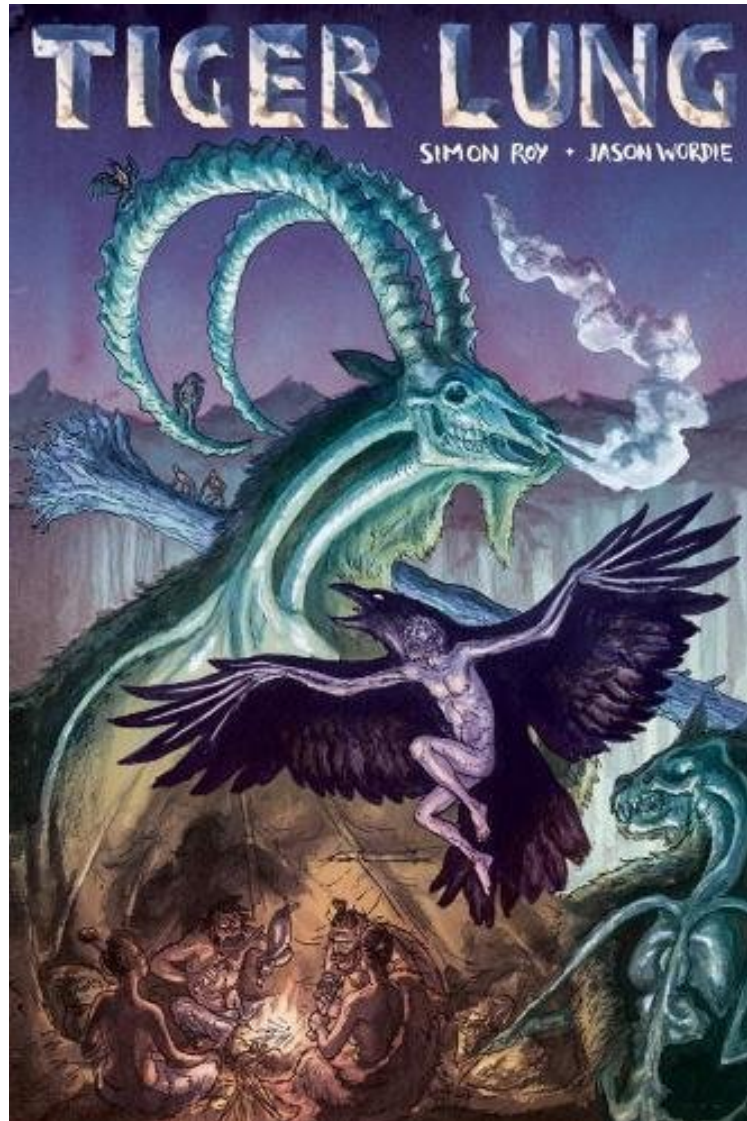

I read someplace that Simon Roy Co. were attempting to "out-Conan" the current run of Conan the Barbarian comics with Image's new Prophet series. I like their Prophet a lot but in terms of getting that Conan feeling, it doesn't succeed quite the way Tiger Lung does. The three stories included in this volume each stand on their own but are presented as part of a series with a chronological sequence (it's laid out on the map pages), and on top of the wonderfully realized Paleolithic

setting, the fantasy elements of Tiger Lung's people like their underworld and various spirits are amazing and horrifying in the same way that those little peeks Conan offered at Lovecraftian horror were.
