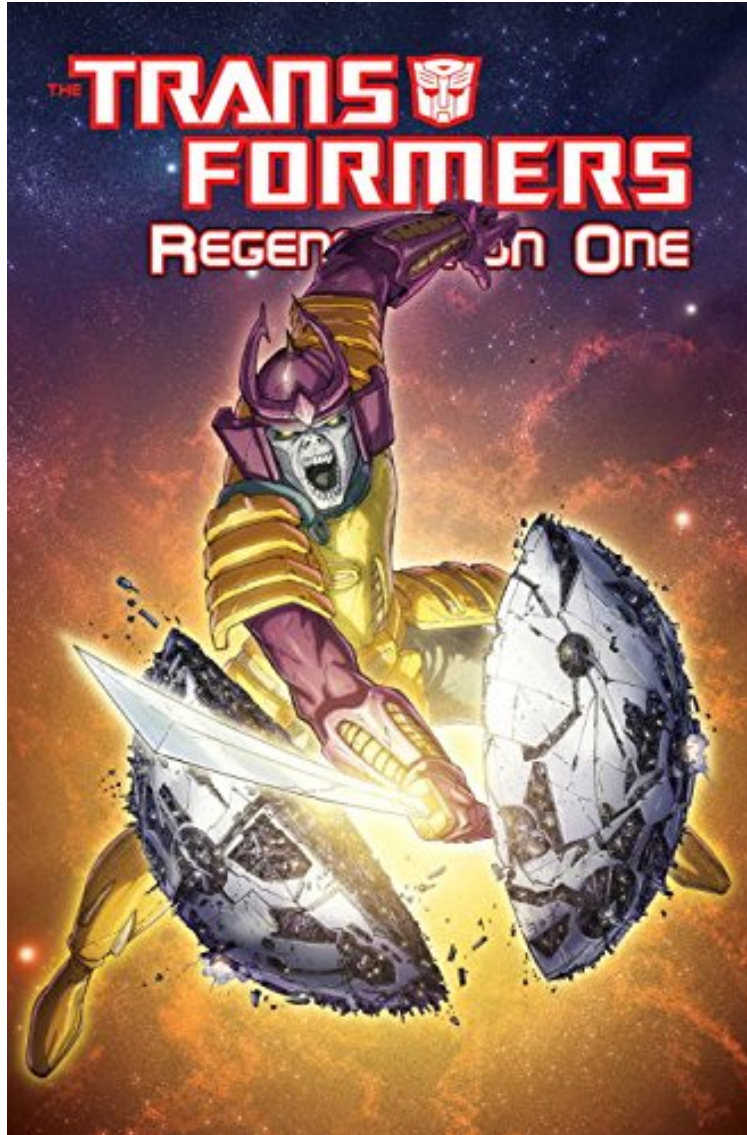

Although I find it somewhat disconcerting that so much emphasis is given to "movie" concepts and characters, this is still a great addition to the legacy of the G1 era comics. It's also my first comic purchase for Kindle Fire, and it looks great! The art is really outstanding and the color really pops.
